
#1 During the current school year (2019-2020), are you enrolled in any learning program?



#2 In the past 90 days, did you work for at least 1 day that is paid?



#2' In the past 30 days, did you work for at least 1 day that is paid?



#2'' What is your Primary Job type?




#3 My identity is mostly defined by my belonging to:
