

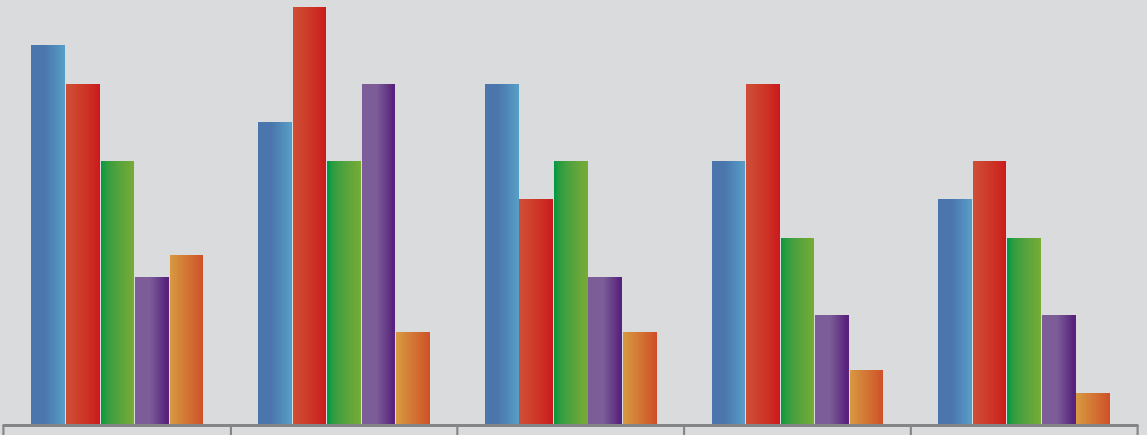

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## مقدمة

تسعى النظم الصحية في العالم إلى ضمان صحة الفرد والتركيز على الوقاية التي اثبتت فعاليتها في تحسين صحة المواطنين وخفض الفاتورة الصحية.

وتشكل الاحصاءات الدعامة الأساسية لمراقبة تقدم النظم الصحية وتصويب الأخطاء ورصد الأولويات في اي دولة كما تتيح مقارنة المناطق مع بعضها البعض، او مقارنة البلد مع البلدان الأخرى.

وتعد النشرة الاحصائية تقريراً سنوياً جامعاً للاحصاءات المتوفرة في وزارة الصحة العامة. وتعزيزاً منها للشفافية في القطاع الصحي، تحرص الوزارة على بناء السياسات الصحية المرتكزة إلى الأدلة العلمية وتوزيع الخدمات على المستفيدين وفقاً لآخر المعطيات الإحصائية والوبائية المتوفرة. كما تندرج هذه النشرة ضمن الجهود التي تبذلها الاخيرة في صنع السياسات الصحية المبنية على المعلومات حول التقديرات الصحية وكيفية توزيع الخدمات على الأراضي اللبنانية كافة بغية إشراك المواطن بالقرار وتأمين حقّه بالإطلاع على تطورات القطاع الصحي.

تعتمد دائرة الاحصاءات إلى تطوير عملها في سياق تطور دورها عبر ابتكارات جديدة في طريقة العمل تقوم على التعاون بين مختلف الأفرقاء المعنيين بحيث يجري الحصول على المعلومات عبر الاعتماد على نقاط اتصال في المراكز المنتجة للمعلومات، داخل وخارج الوزارة ومنها المستشفيات والجهات الرسمية الضامنة. الى جانب ذلك يتم استحداث تكنولوجيا لإرسال ومعالجة ونشر المعلومات، مما يخفف الحاجة لعدد أكبر من الموظفين ويشكل خطوة ثابتة نحو الحكومة الإلكترونية.

إلى جانب جمع المعلومات داخل الإدارة المركزية، تتلقى الآن دائرة الاحصاءات معلومات من الأقضية كافة فيما يتعلق بالولادات والوفيات وذلك ضمن التعاون القائم مع وزارة الداخلية والبلديات عبر نظام ممكن بحيث يتم تلقي المعلومات فور ادخالها في مراكز الأقضية.

أما فيما يتعلق بالوفيات الحاصلة في المستشفيات، ففي العام 2017 تم استحداث "نظام الإبلاغ عن أسباب الوفيات في المستشفيات" بالتعاون مع منظمة الصحة العالمية ونقابة المستشفيات. وفي العامين 2017 و 2018 وصل عدد الوفيات الحاصلة في المستشفيات (الحكومية والخاصة)، والموتقة بأسباب وفاة طبية إلى ما يفوق ال 80% من مجمل وقوعات وفيات اللبنانيين المقيمين المسجلة في وزارة الداخلية والبلديات. وسبب تطوير هذا النظام دورياً عبر تدريب الأطباء ونقاط الإتصال في المستشفيات كما العمل على تحسين نوعية المعلومات ورفع نسبة الإبلاغ.

وتقوم الدائرة بالعمل على الحسابات الصحية الوطنية لإلقاء الضوء على كلفة الفاتوره الصحية إن كان على الدولة أو ما تشكله من عبء على جيب المواطن. أظهرت هذه الحسابات ان كلفة الصحة السنوية للفرد في لبنان تقدر للعام 2017 ب 936 دولاراً وإجمالي الإنفاق على الصحة يشكل 7.75% من الناتج القومي المحلي منها 33.1% انفاق مباشر من جيب المواطن، بعد ان انخفضت تلك النسبة من 37.3% في العام 2012.

انطلاقاً من ذلك كله، إننا ننوه بالجهود المستمرة لدائرة الاحصاءات والموظفين الذين عملوا على توفير ومعالجة المعلومات، ونخص بالشكر أيضاً منظمة الصحة العالمية على الدعم التقني لإمكانية جعل هذه النشرة بين أيديكم.

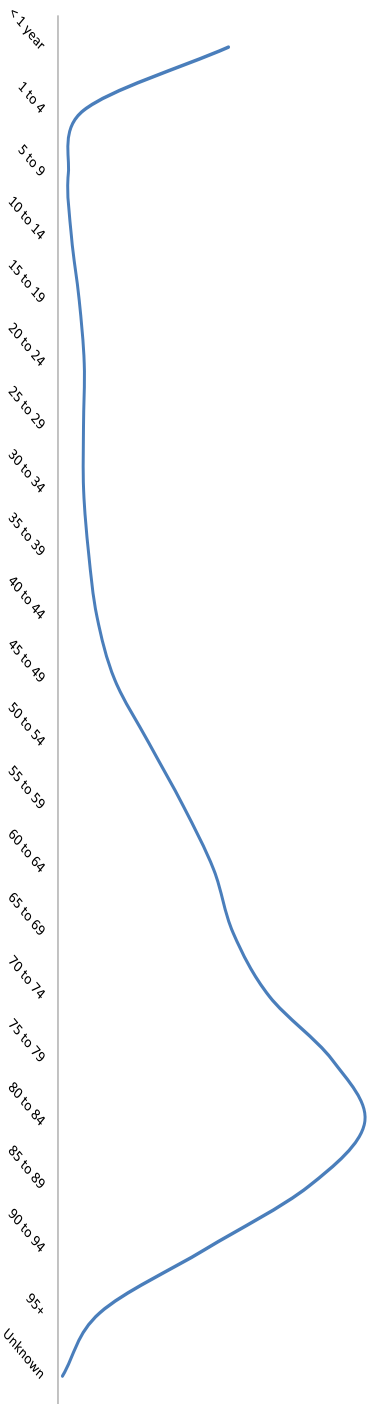

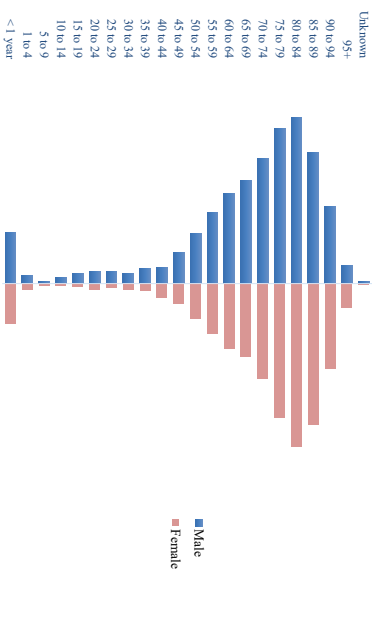

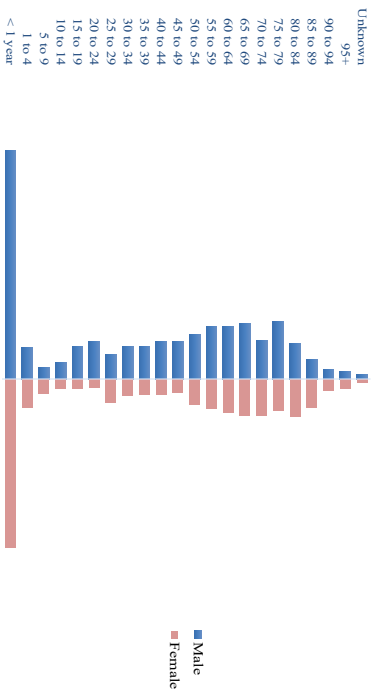
**Graph B.1: Proportion of reported hospital deaths by age group and gender (N=18,197), 2018**

**Distribution of reported non-Lebanese hospital deaths by age group and gender (N=2,787), 2018**



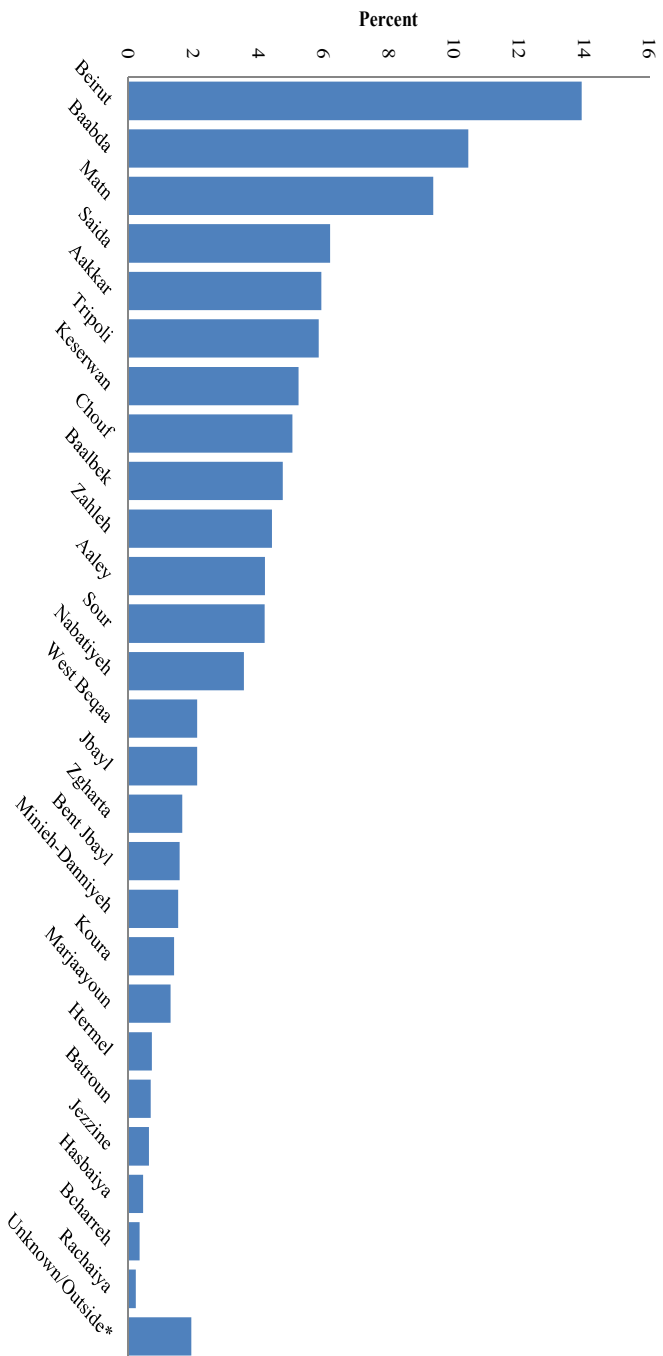

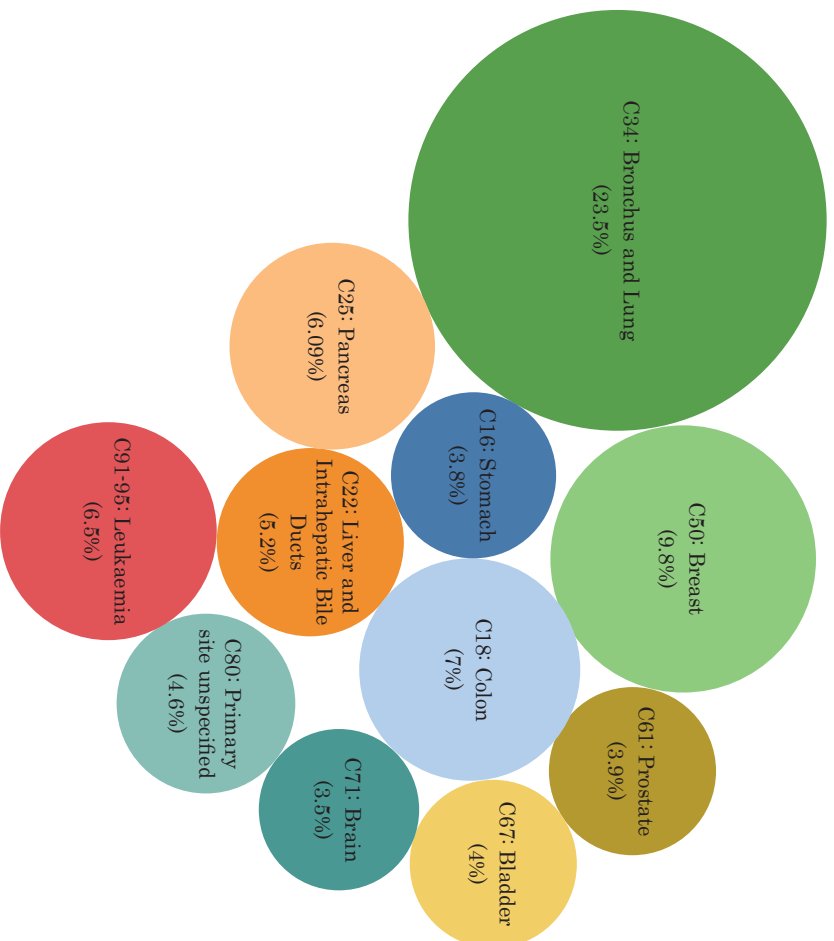
**Graph B.3: Proportion of reported hospital deaths by gada of residence (N=18,197), 2018**

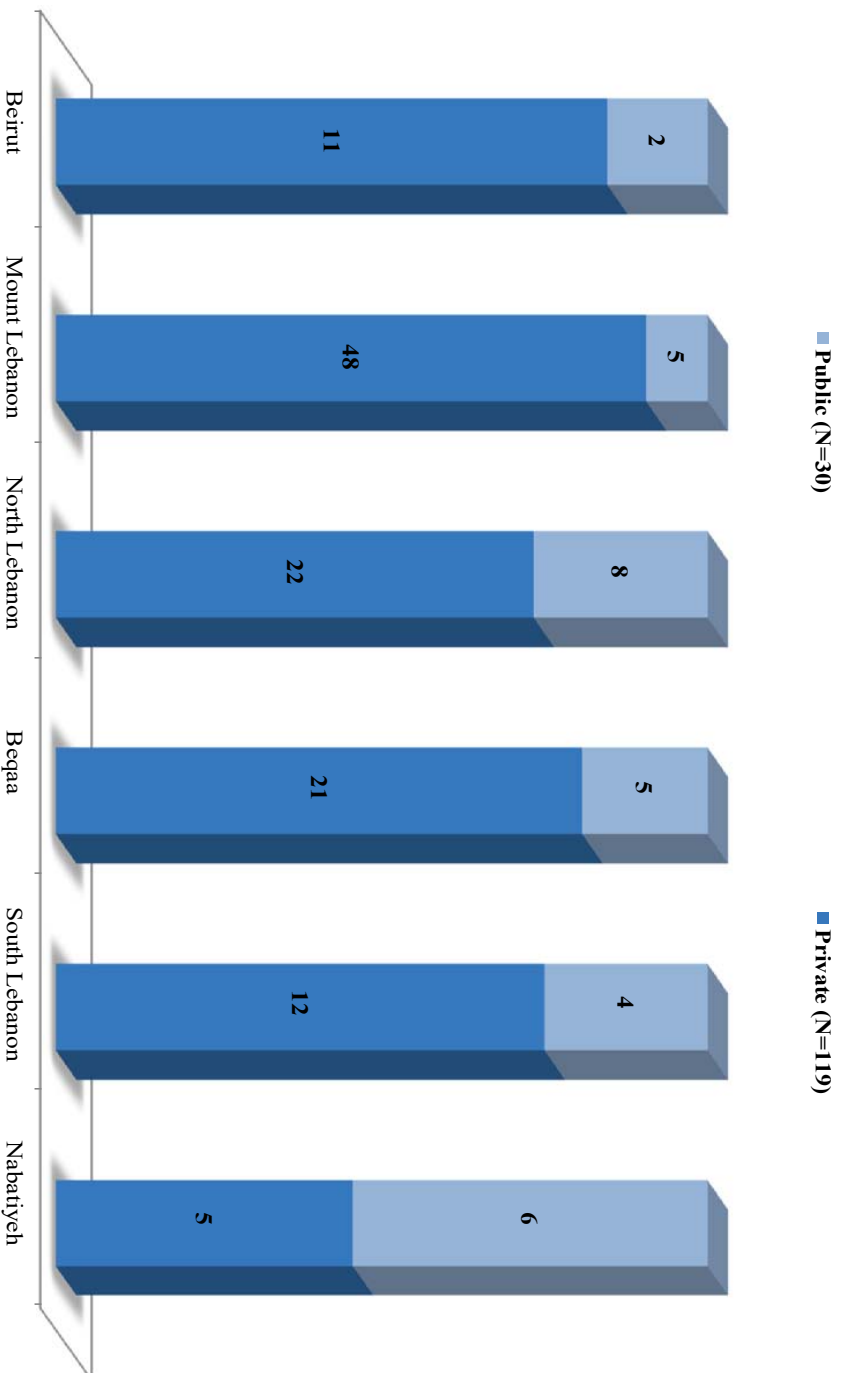
**Graph B.4: Top 10 cancers\* by ICD10 3-Character code, 2018**

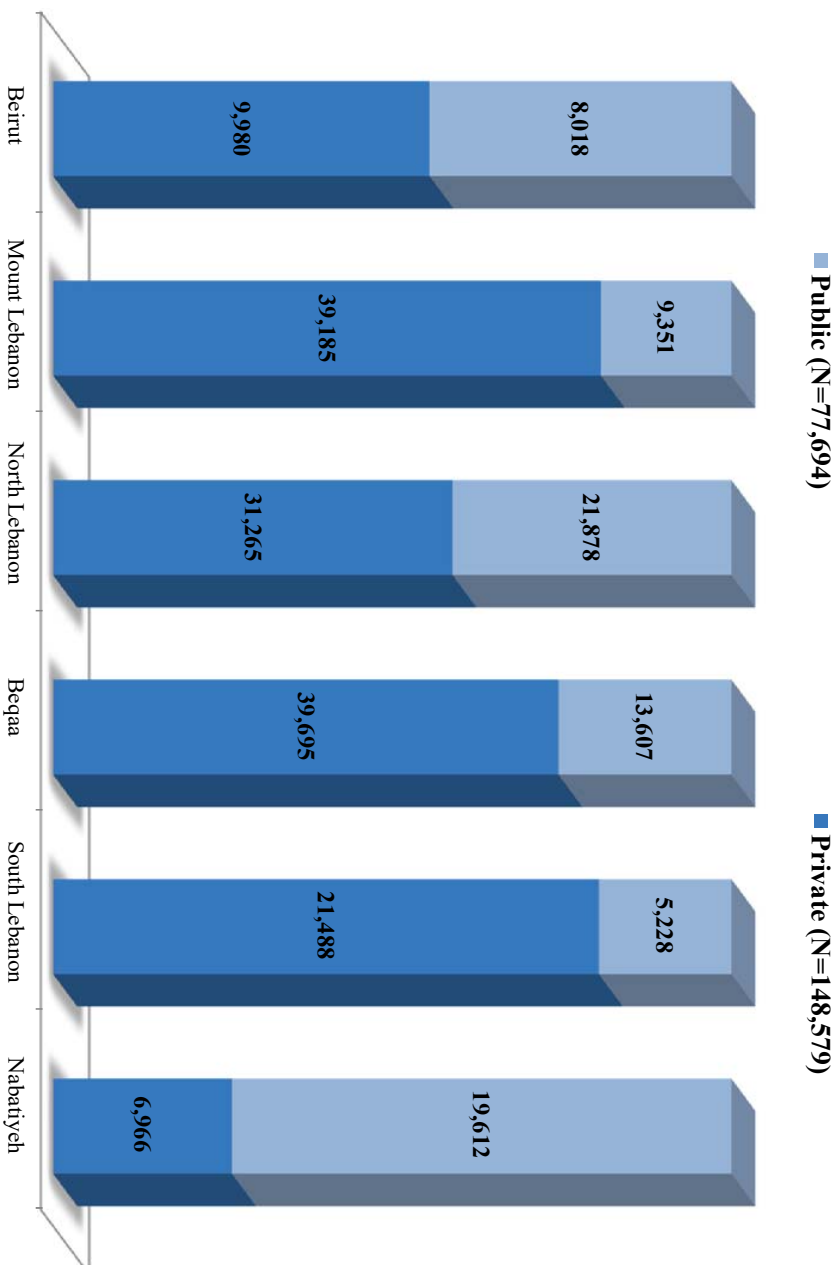

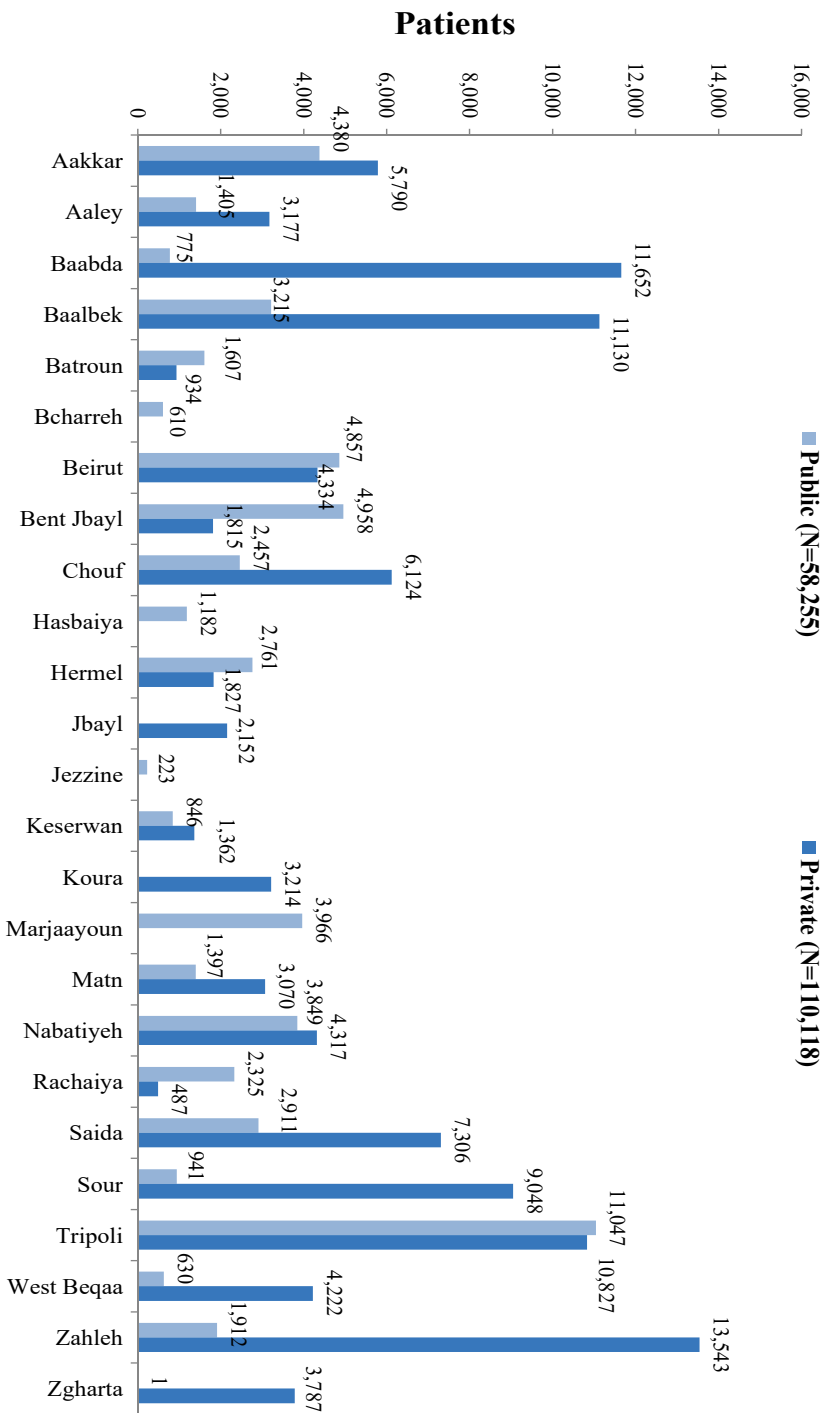
**Graph C.2: MoPH subsidized admissions by Mohafaza and type of hospital, 2018**

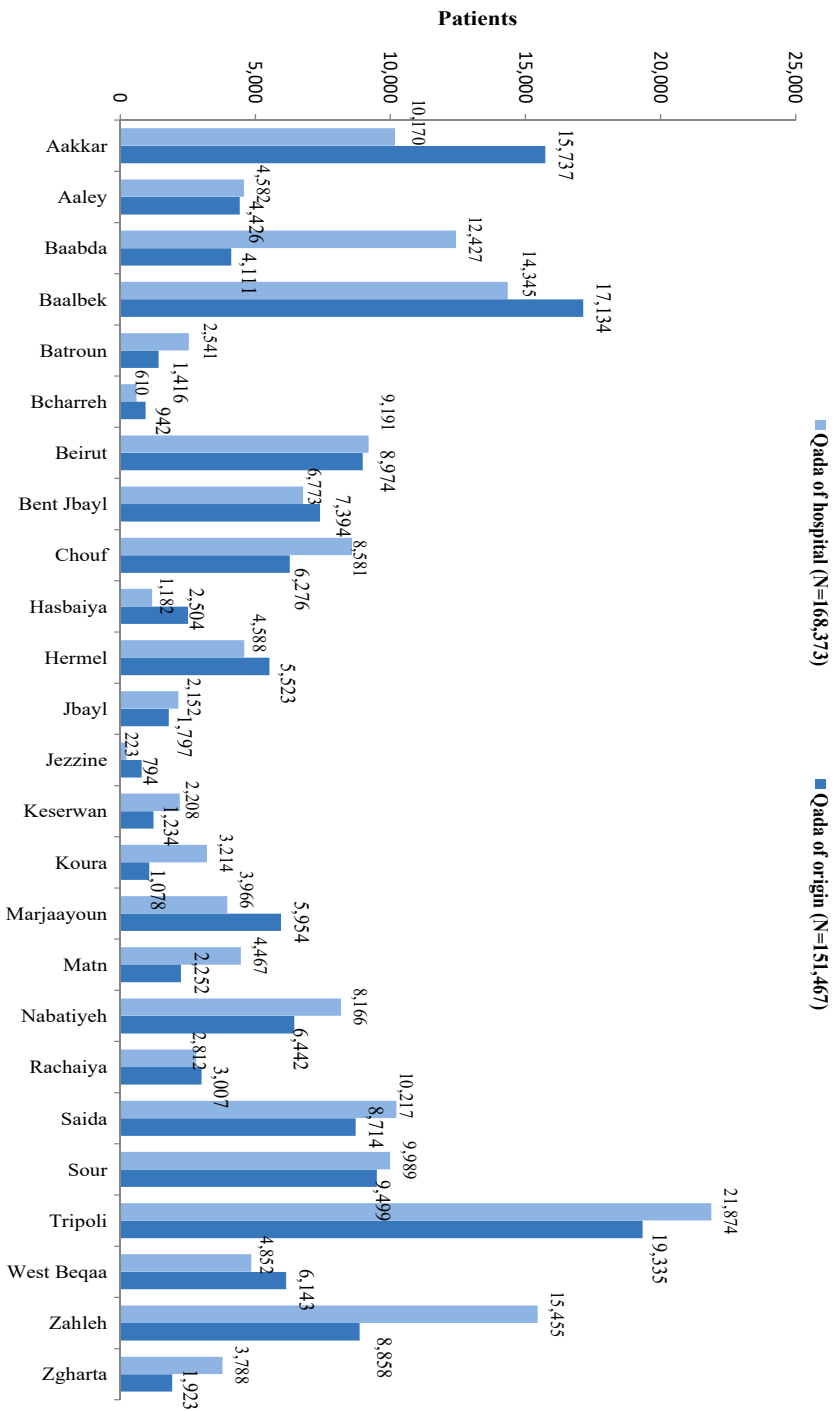


**Graph C.3: MoPH subsidized in-patients by Qada and type of hospital, 2018**



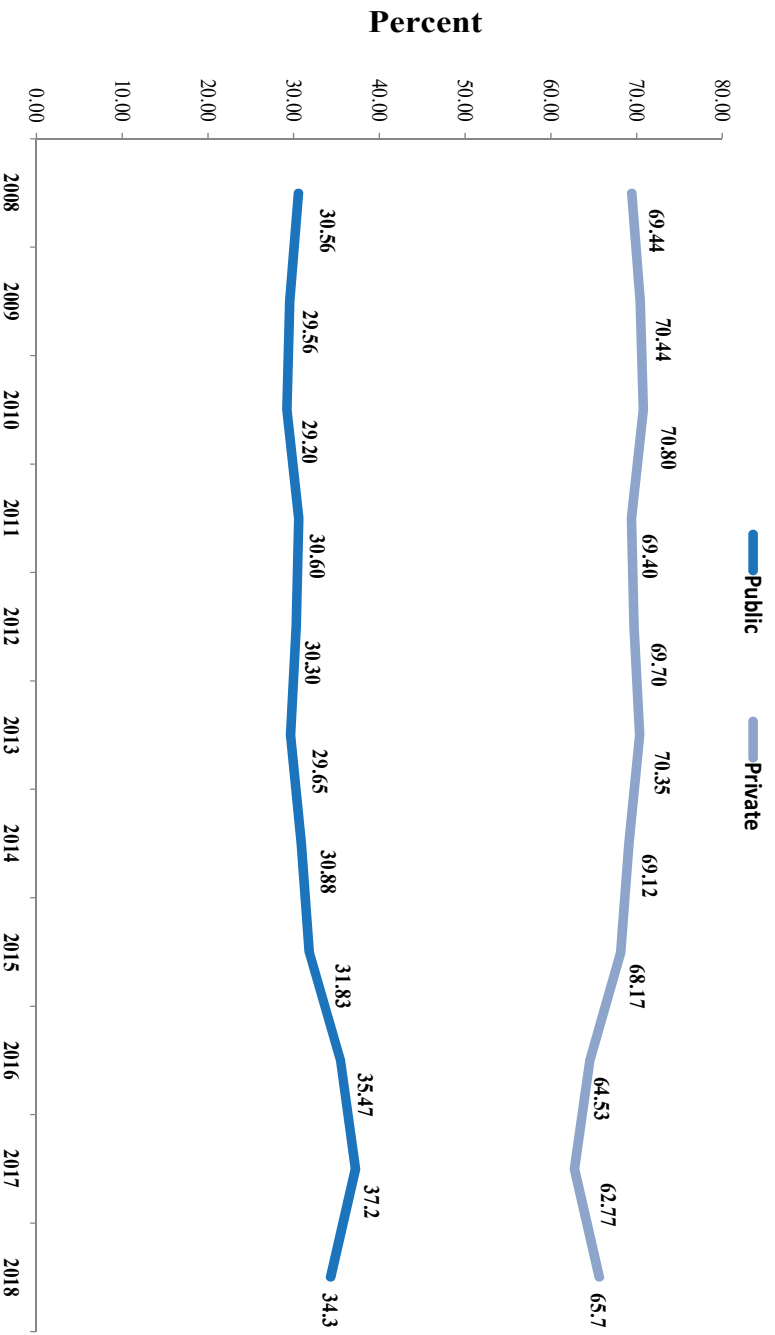

**Graph C.4: MoPH subsidized in-patients by Qada of hospital and Qada of origin, 2018**



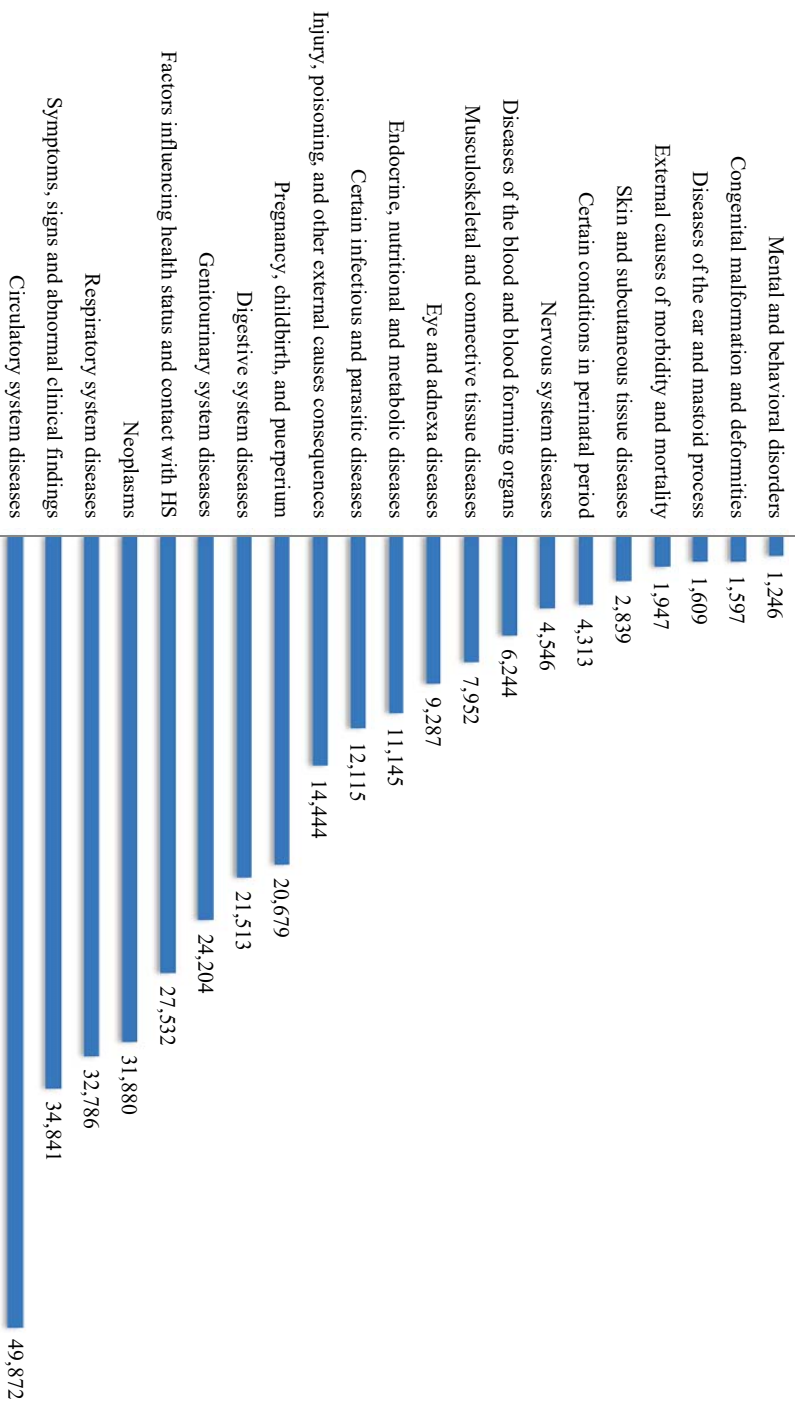

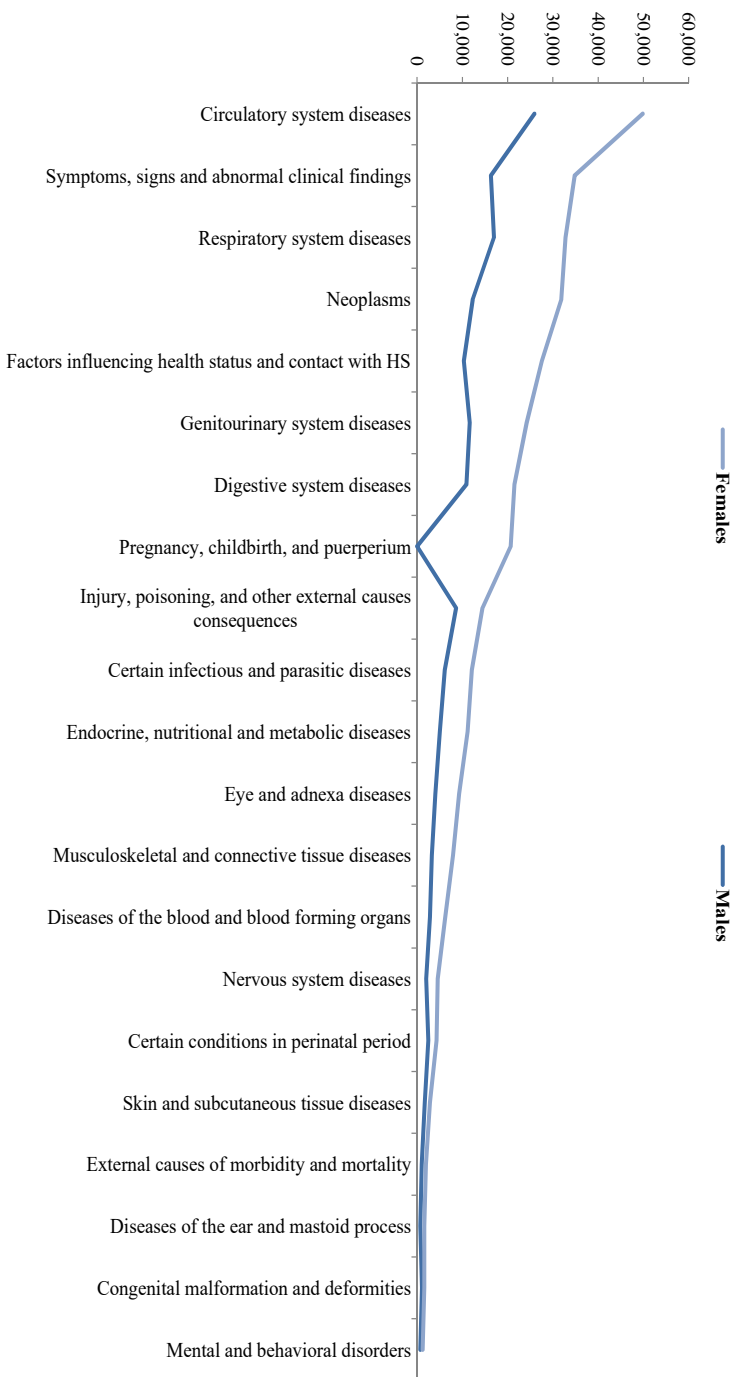
**Graph C.6: MoPH subsidized hospital cases\* by ICD10 category of diagnosis (N=322,591), 2018**

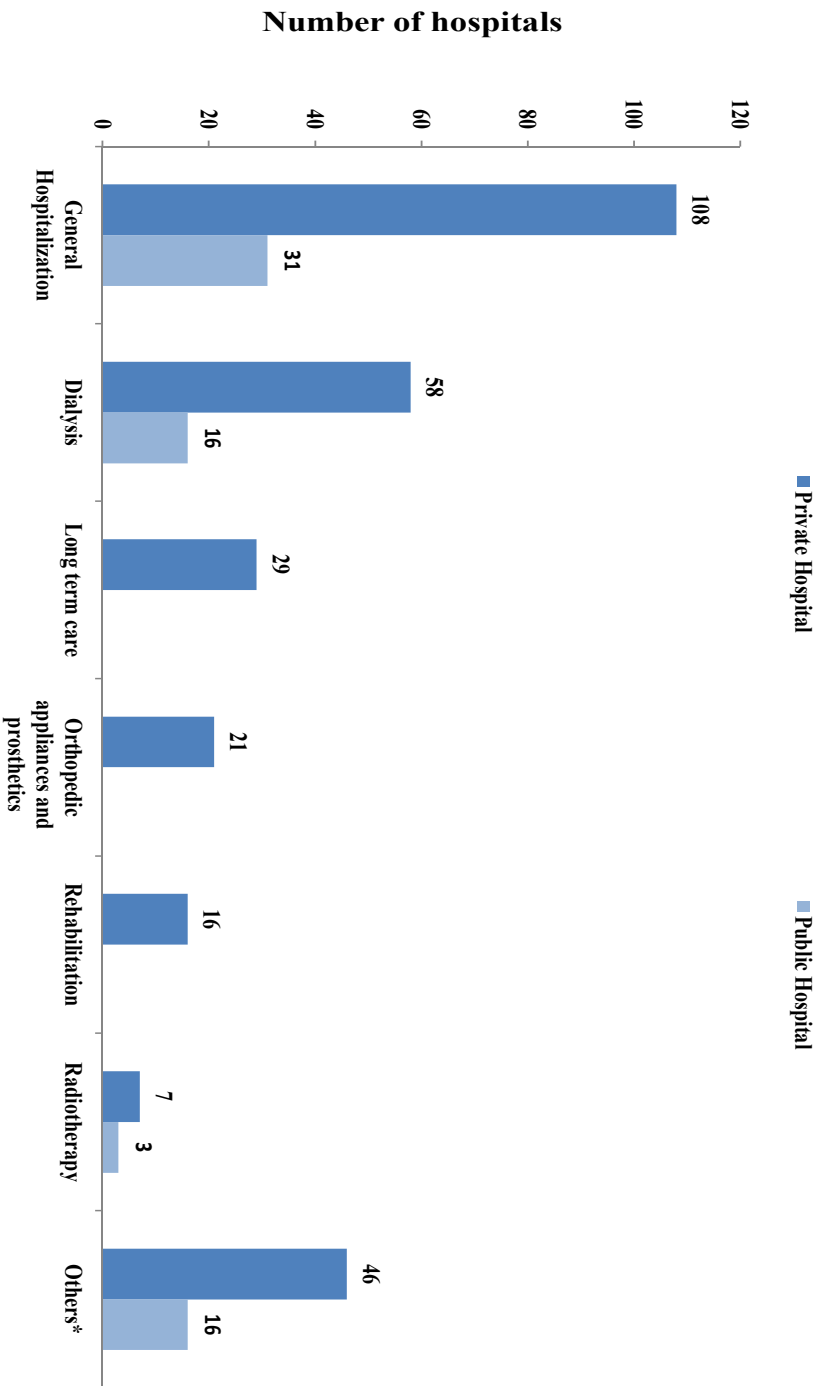

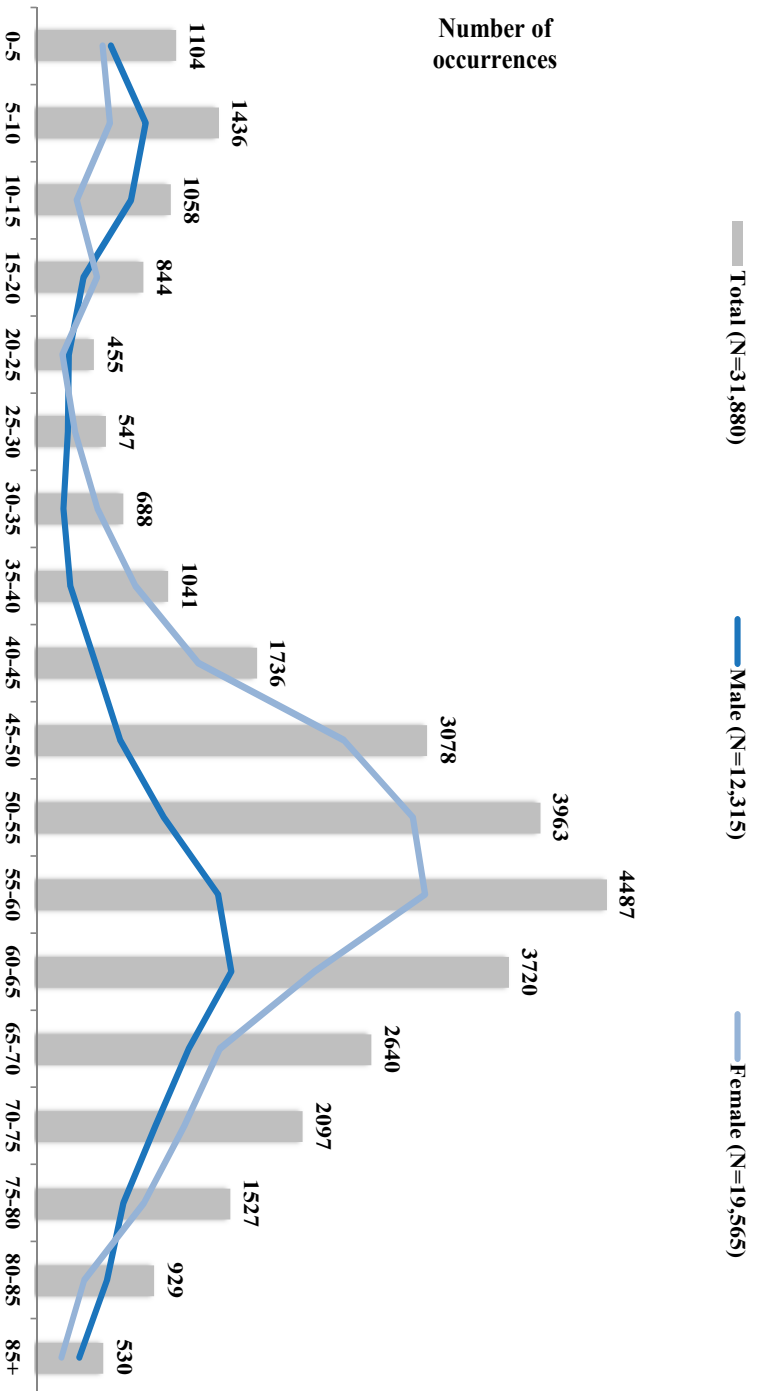

**Graph D.1: MoPH subsidized hospitalized\* neoplasms cases\*\* by gender and age group, 2018**

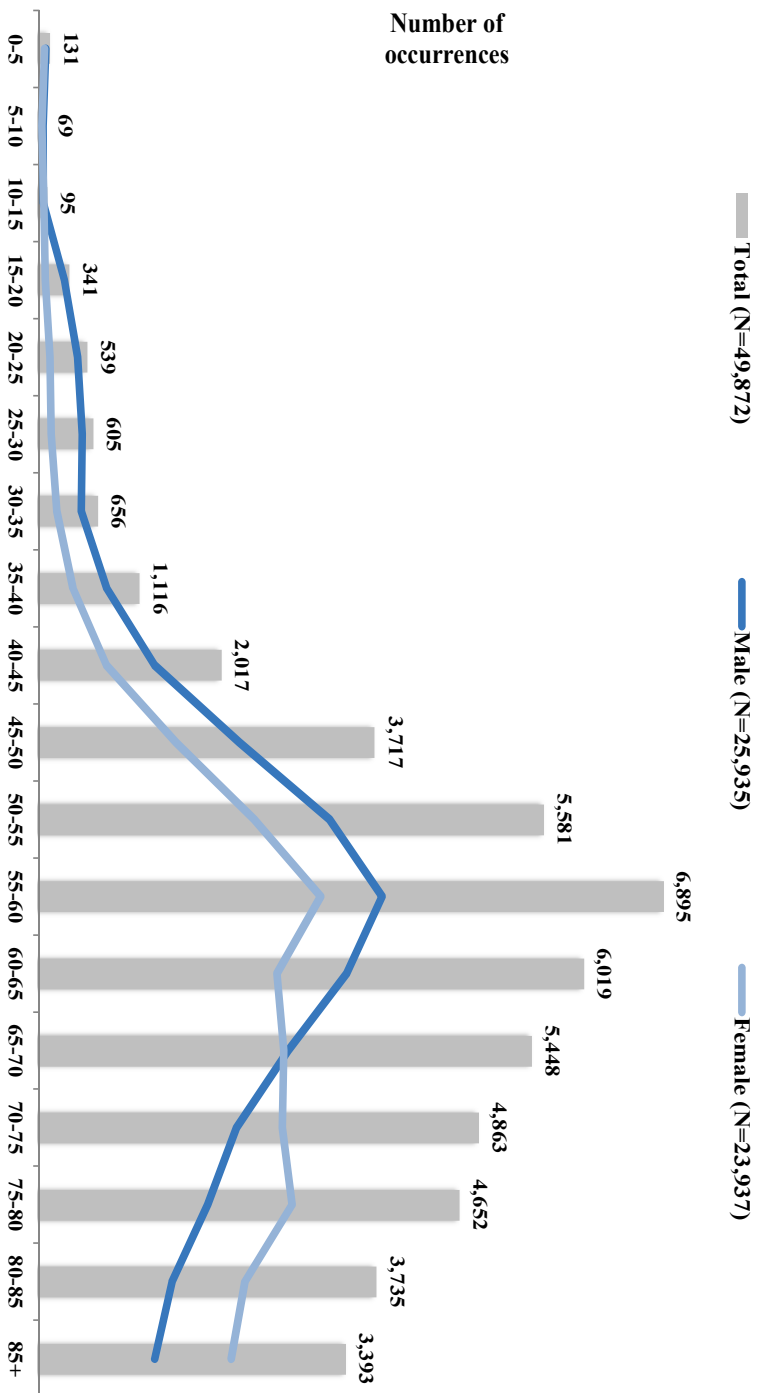

**Graph D.2: MoPH subsidized hospitalized\* cardiovascular cases\*\* by gender and age group, 2018**



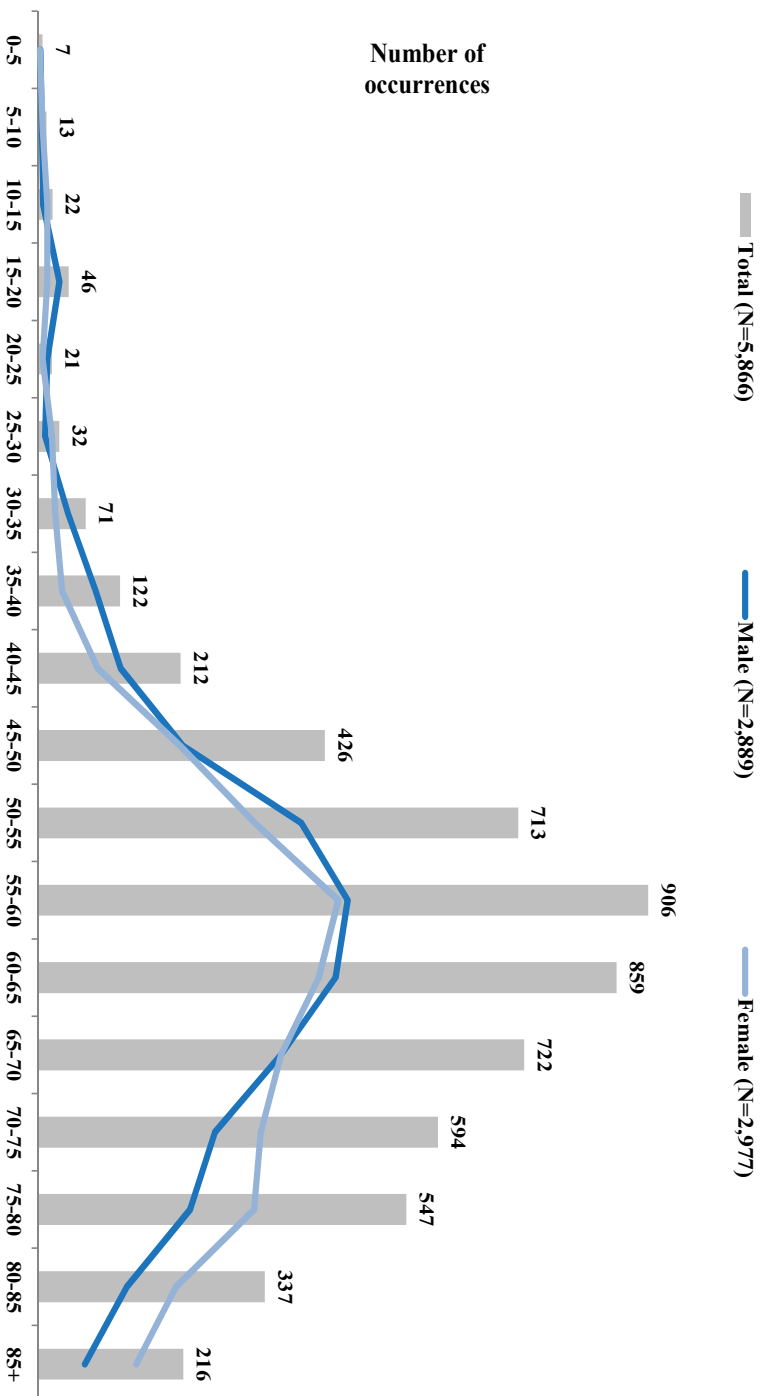

**Graph D.3: MoPH subsidized hospitalized\* diabetes mellitus cases\*\* by gender and age group, 2018**

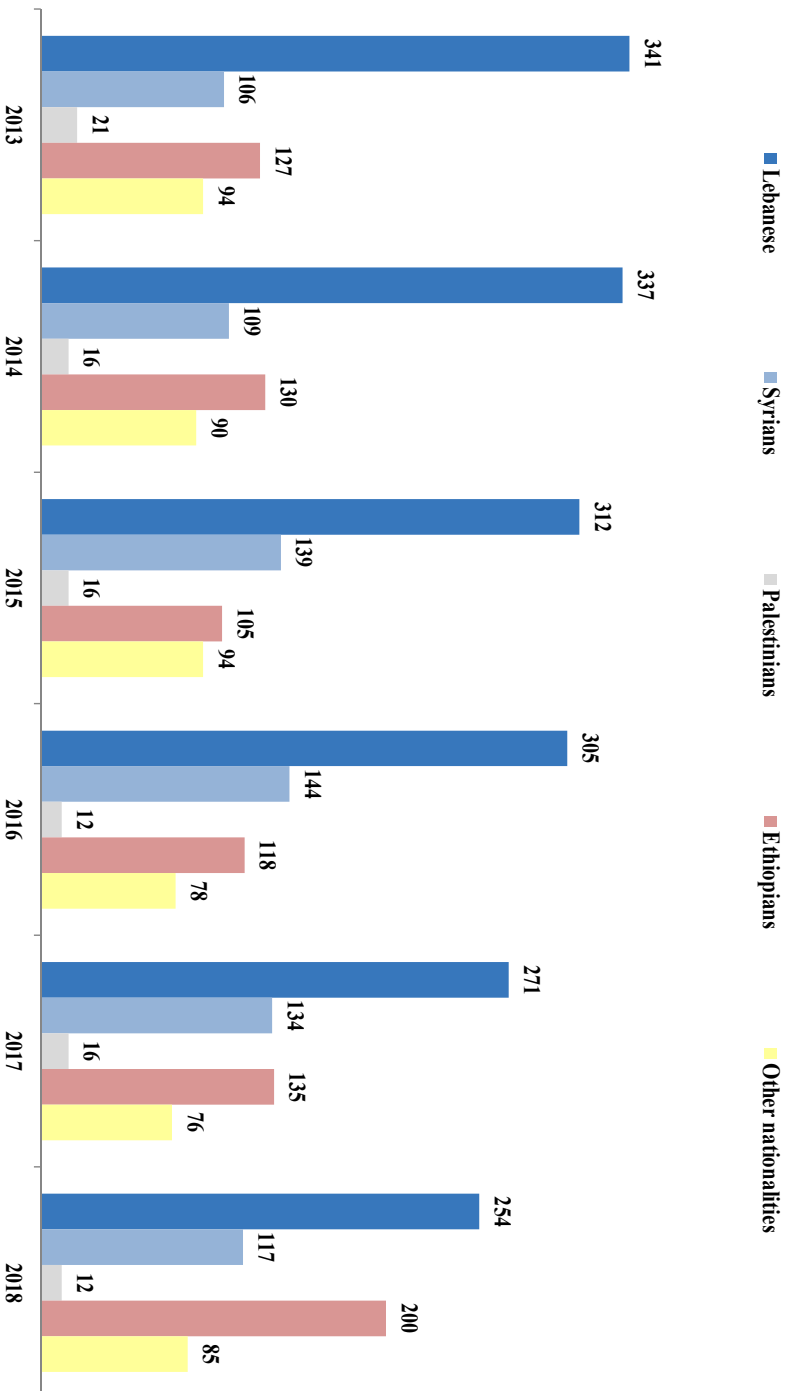

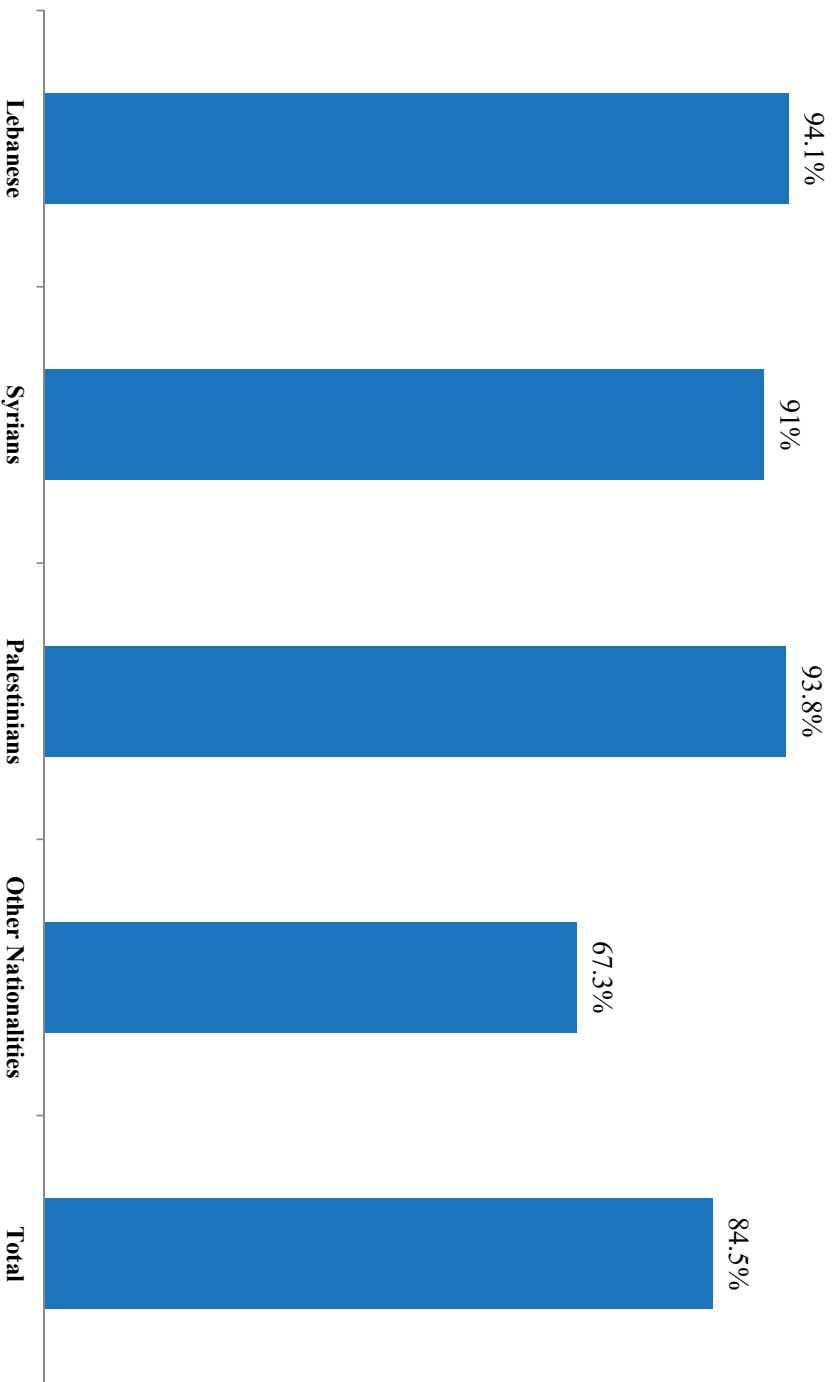

**Graph D.5: Proportion of tuberculosis treatment success by nationality, 2017**



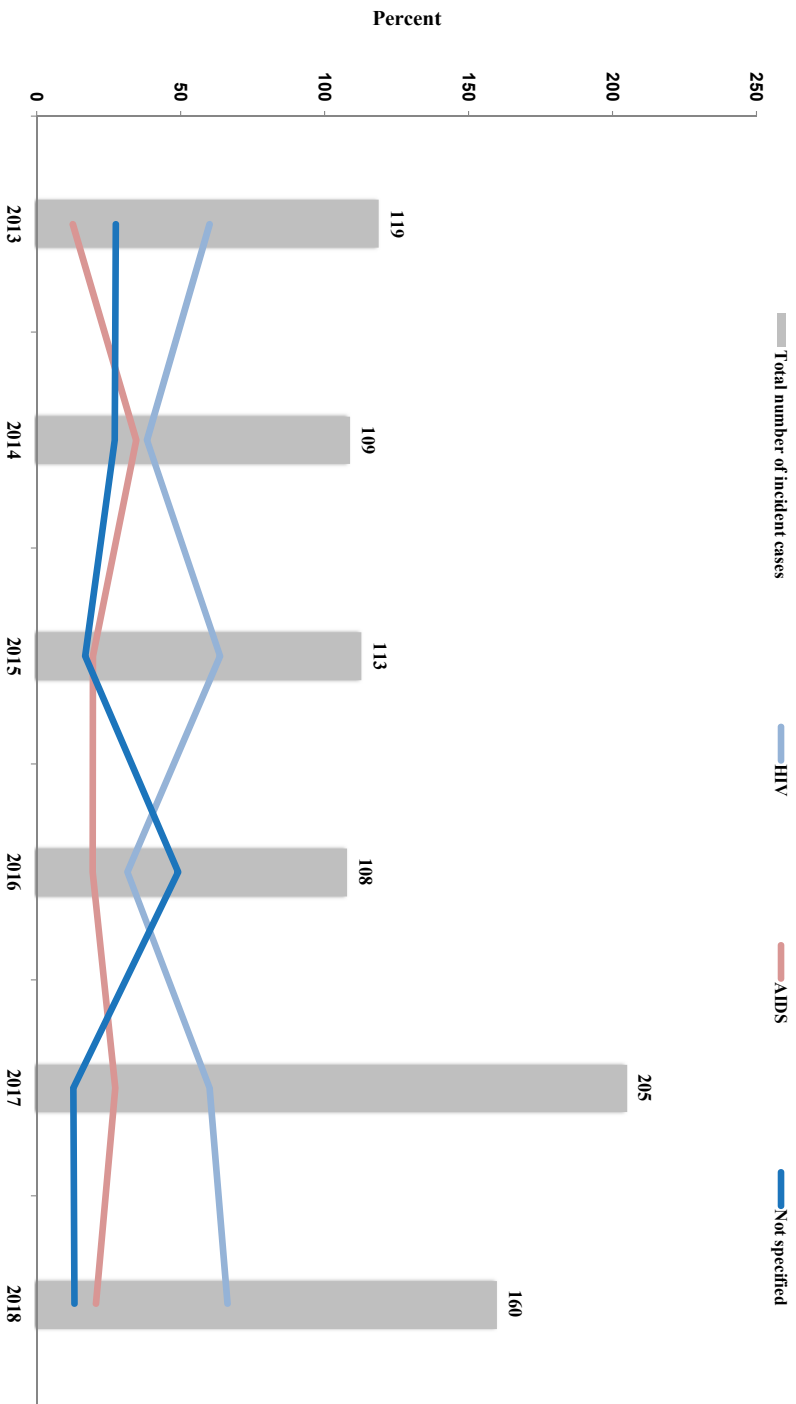

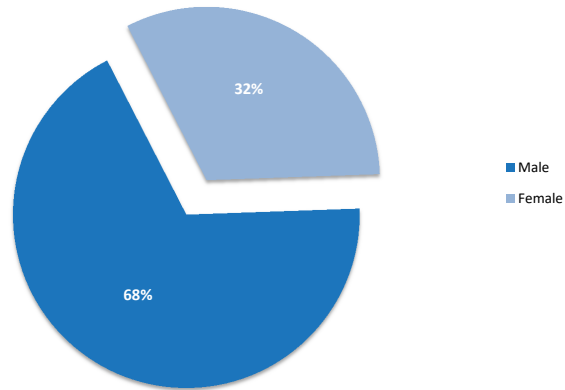

**Graph D.6: Incident cases of HIV/AIDS, 2013 - 2018**

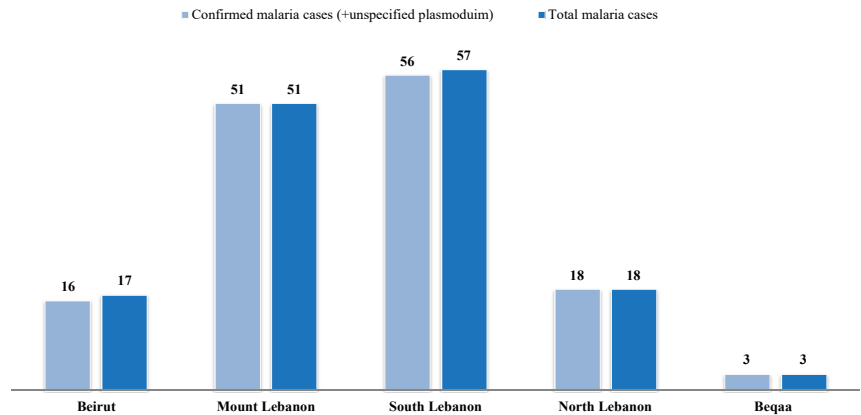

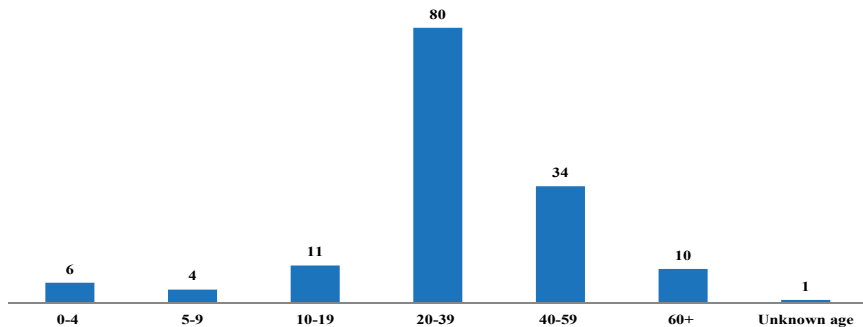
**Graph D.7: Reported cases of malaria by gender, 2018**



**Graph D.8: Confirmed malaria cases by Mohafaza, 2018**

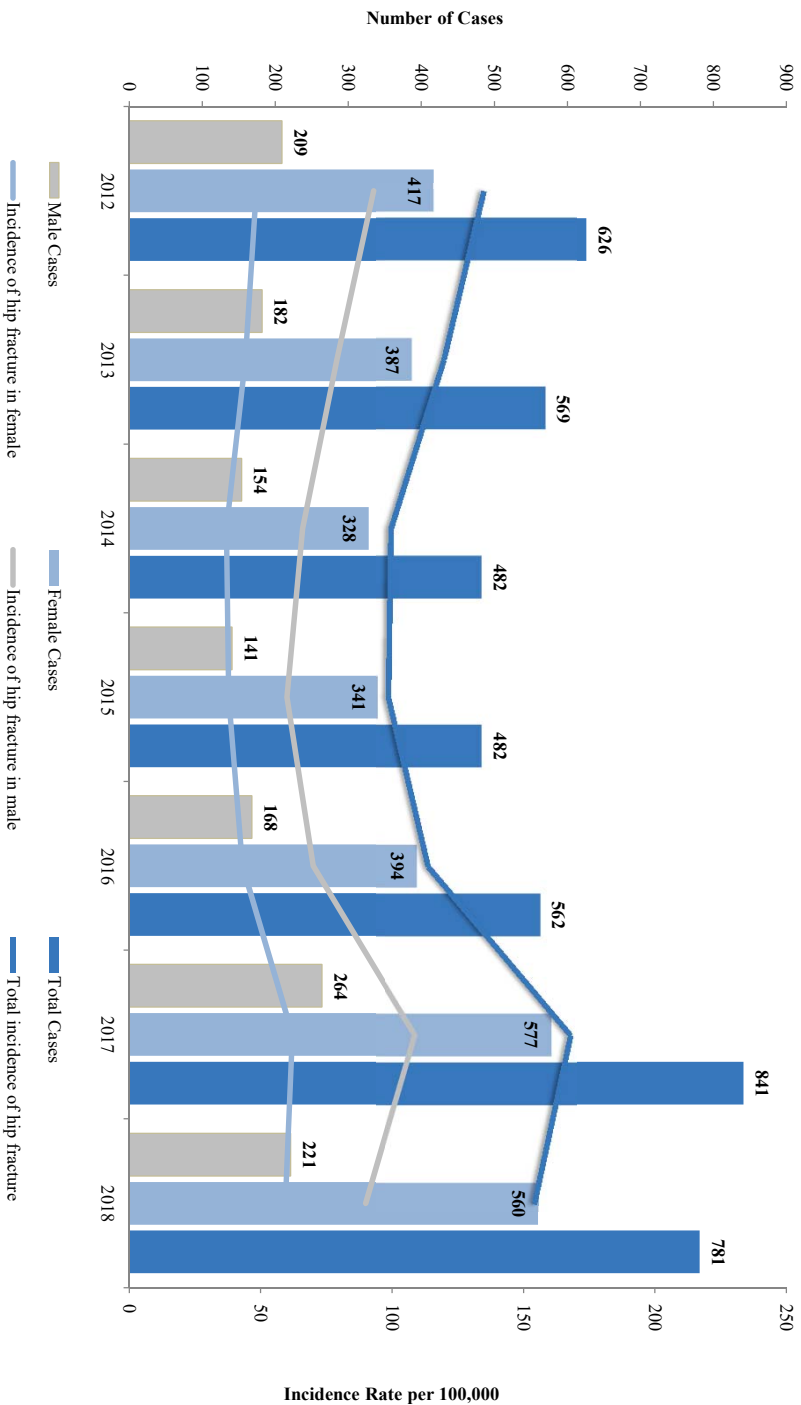


**Graph D.9: Reported cases of malaria by age group, 2018**

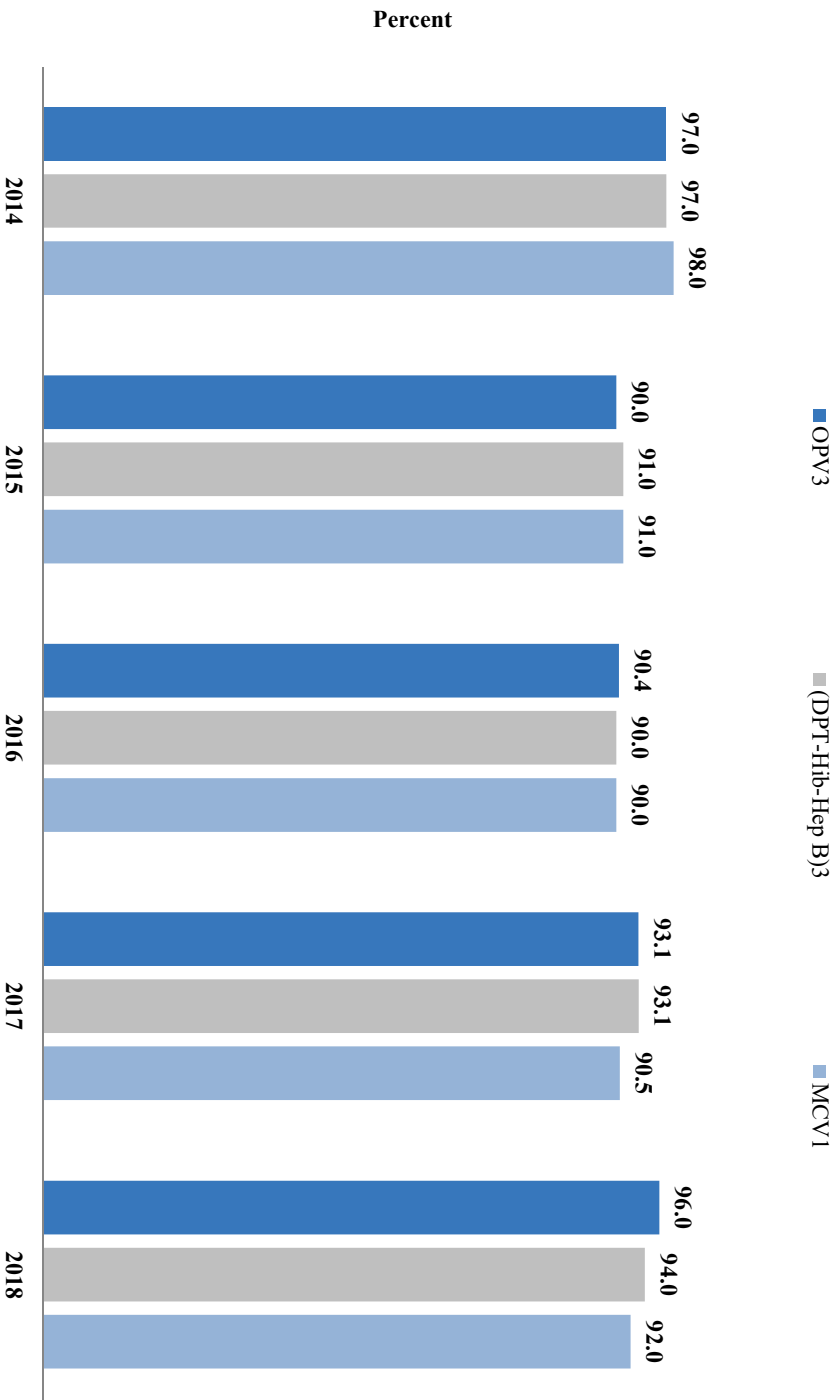
**Graph D.10: Hip fracture cases\* and incidence rate among MoPH eligible population by gender, 2012 - 2018**

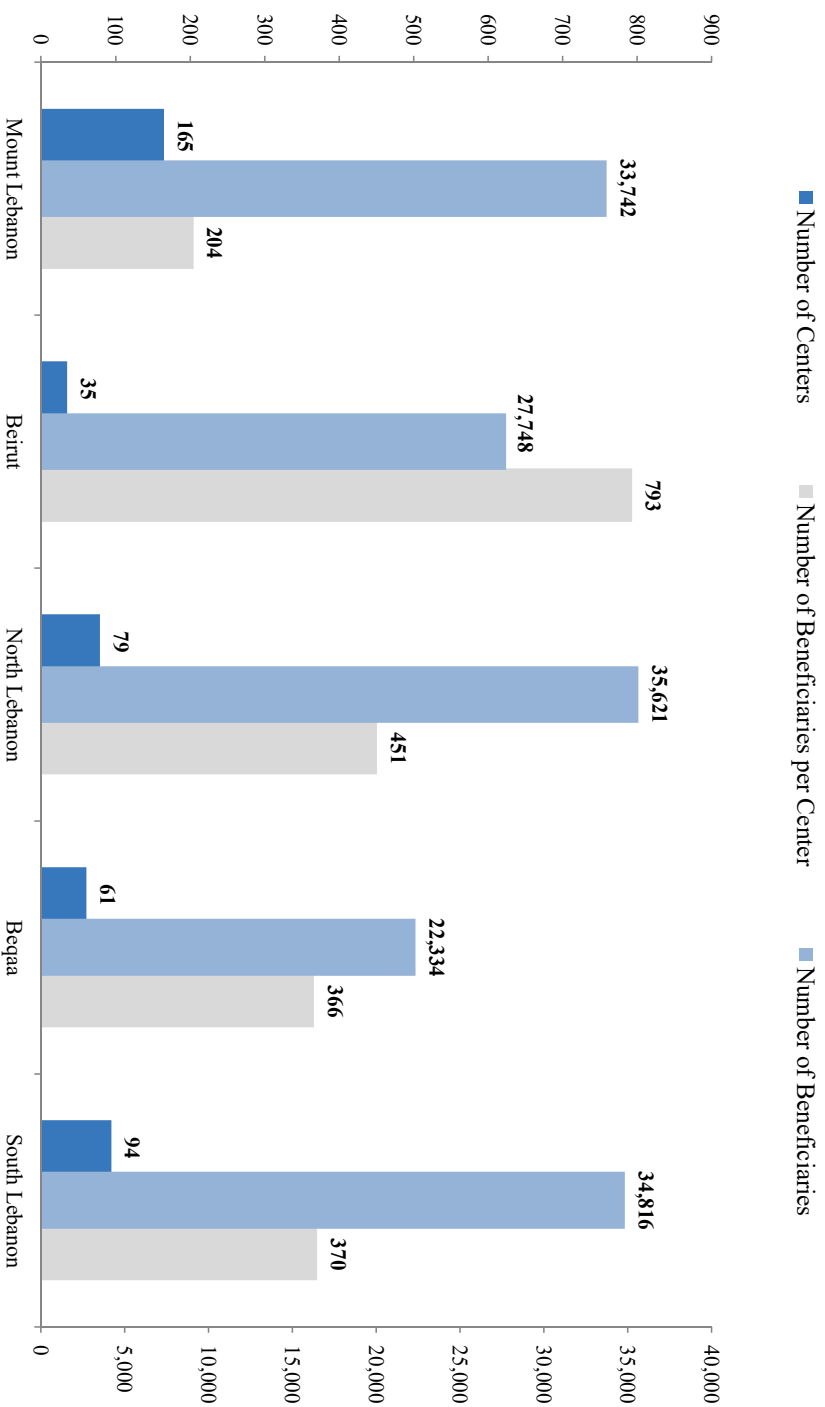

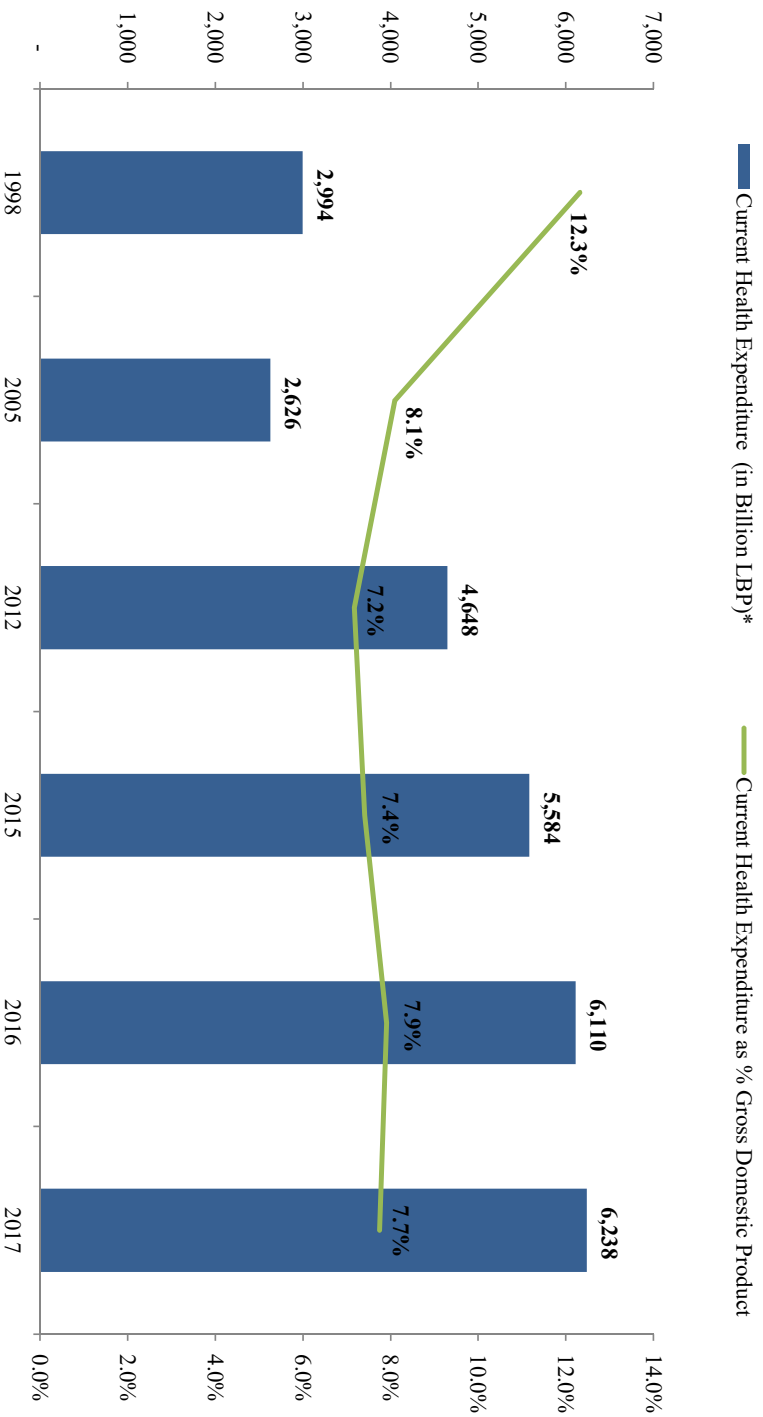
**Graph H.1 : Socio-medical centers and beneficiaries per center by Mohafaza, 2016**

**Graph I1: Current health expenditure as % gross domestic product in the years health accounts data are available**

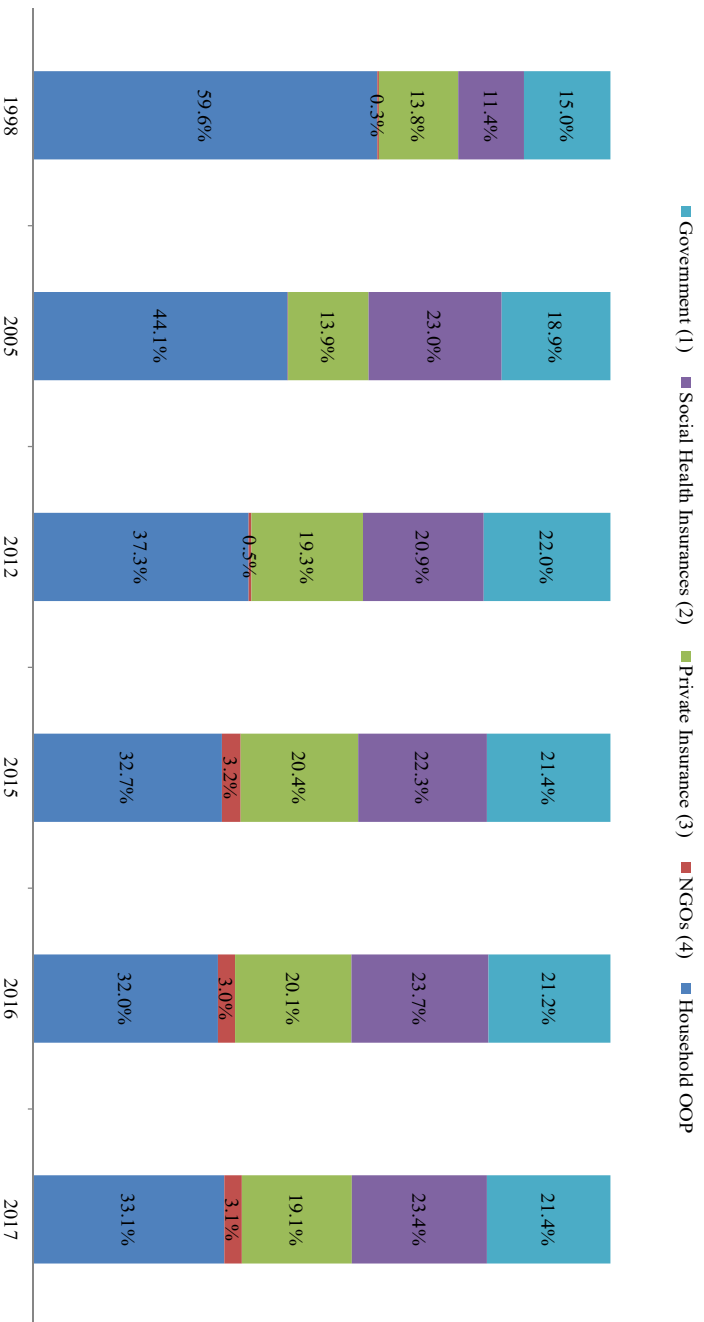

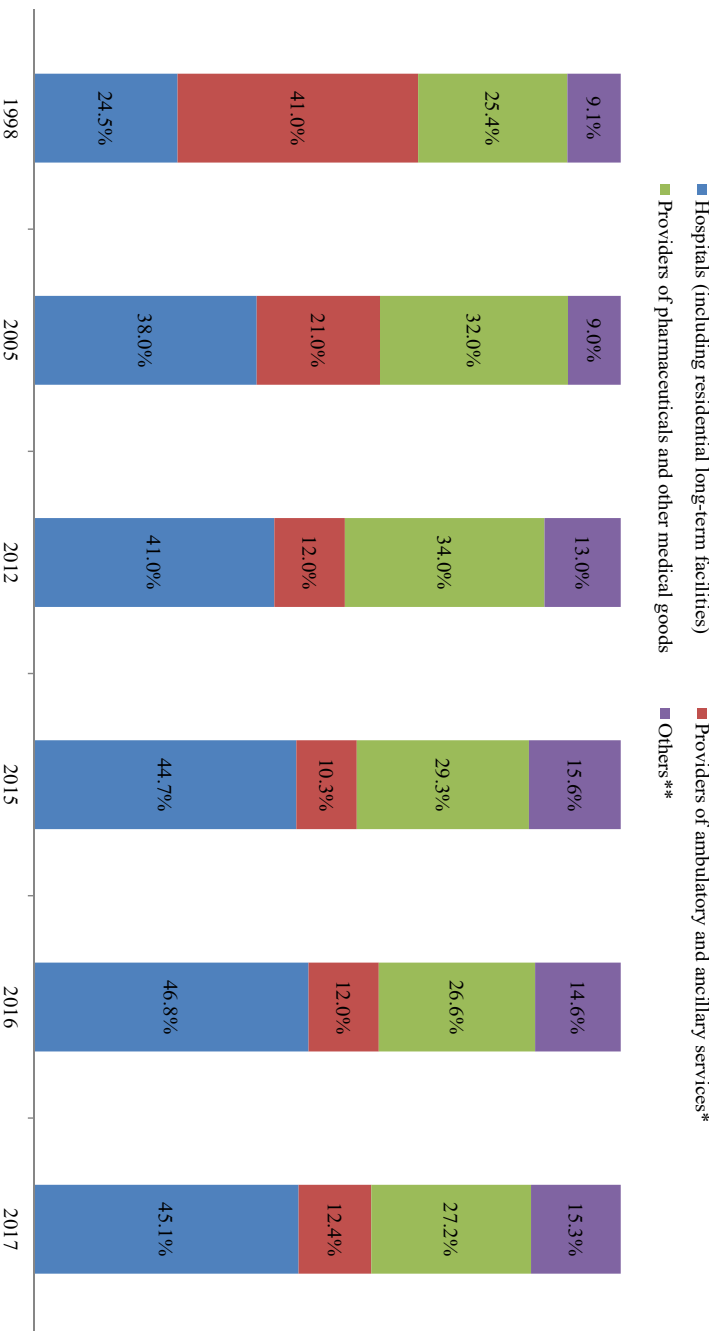

**Graph I.3: Distribution of healthcare expenditure by type of provider in the years health accounts data are available**

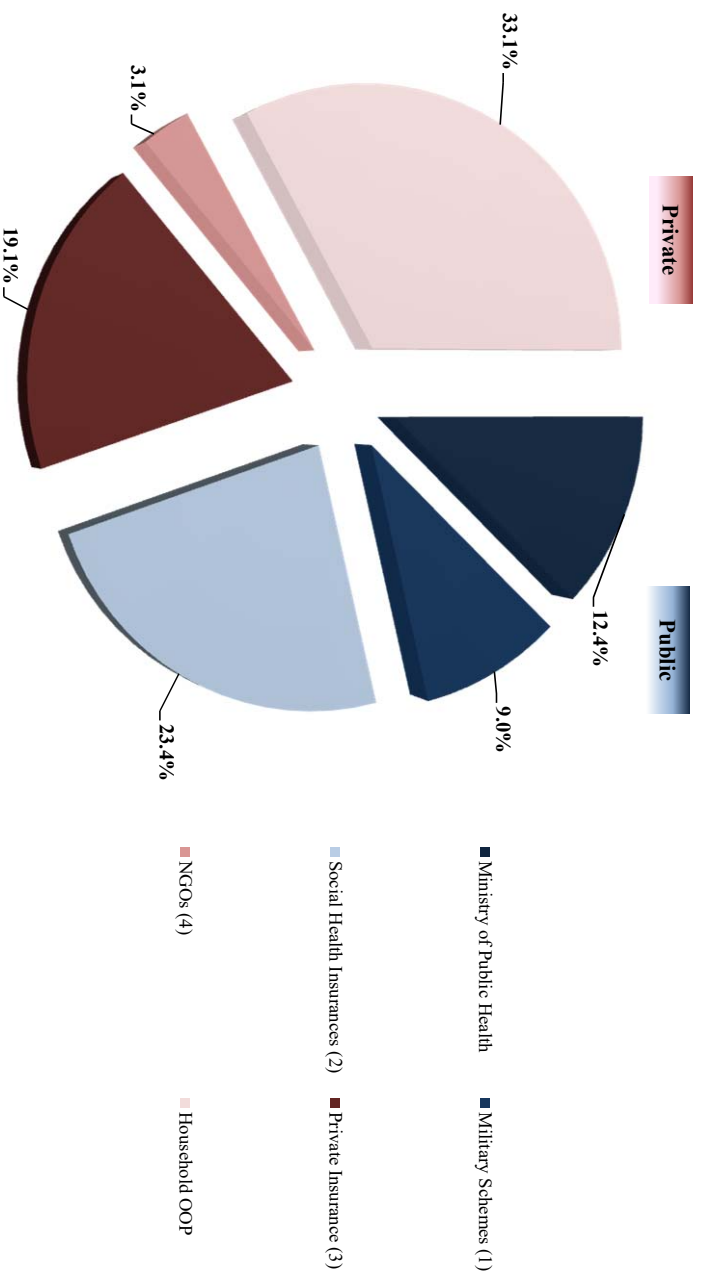

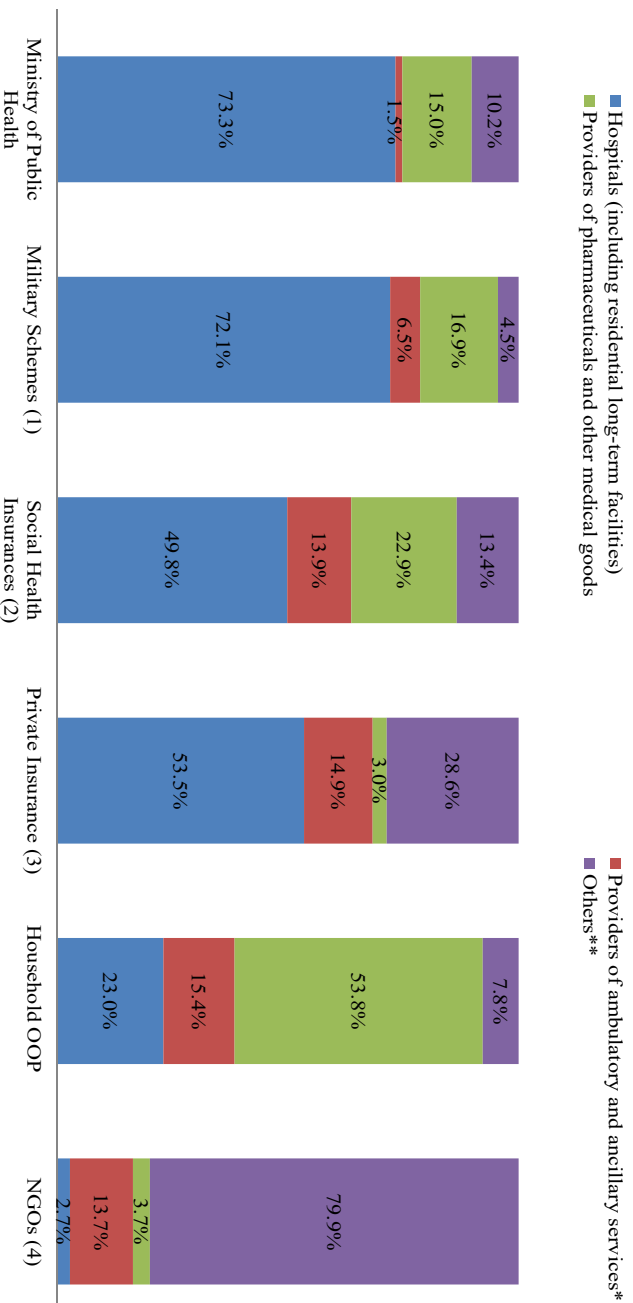


