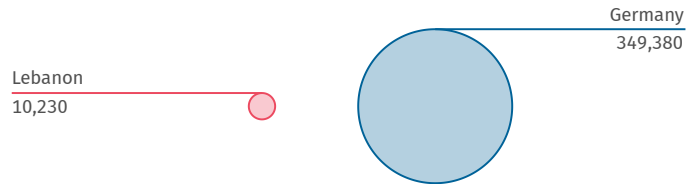

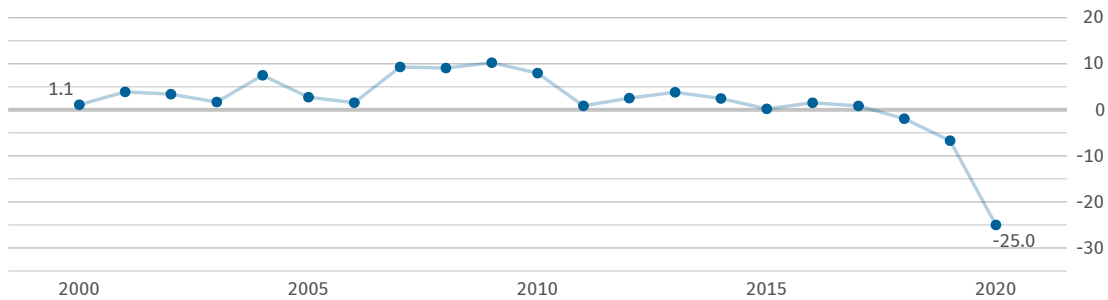

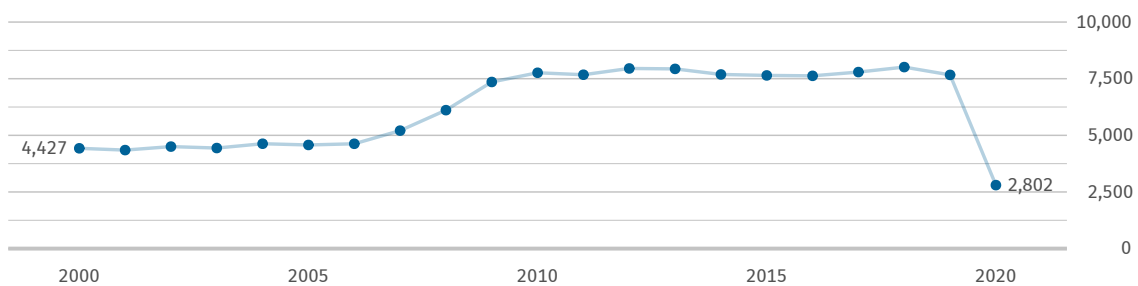

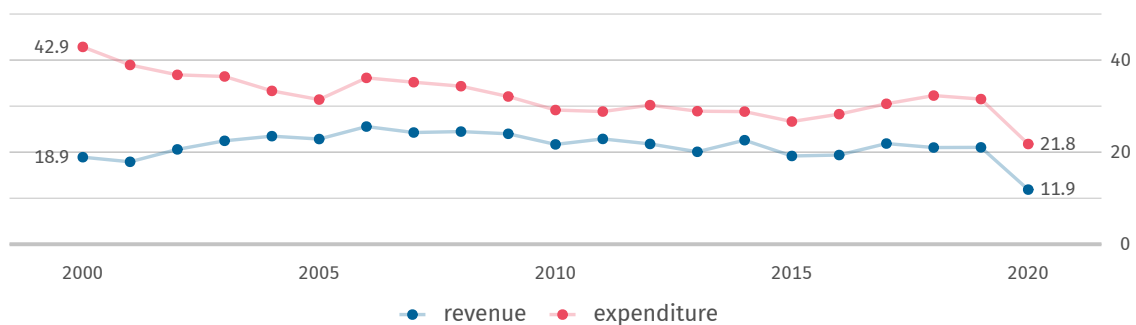

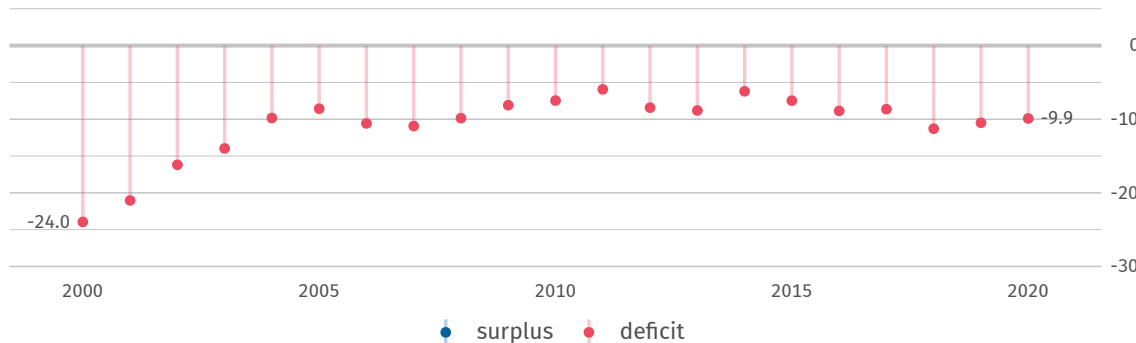

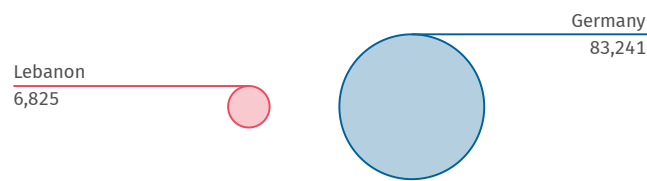

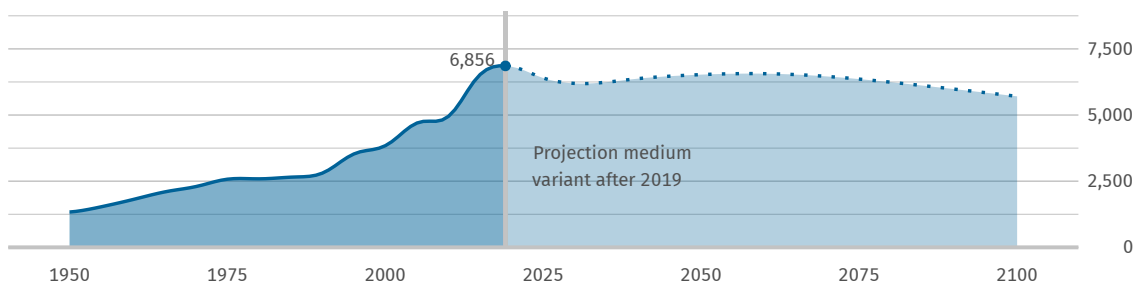

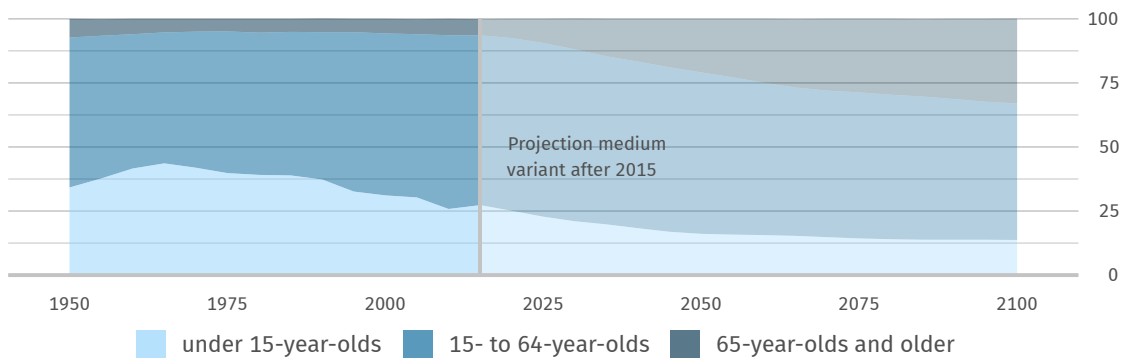

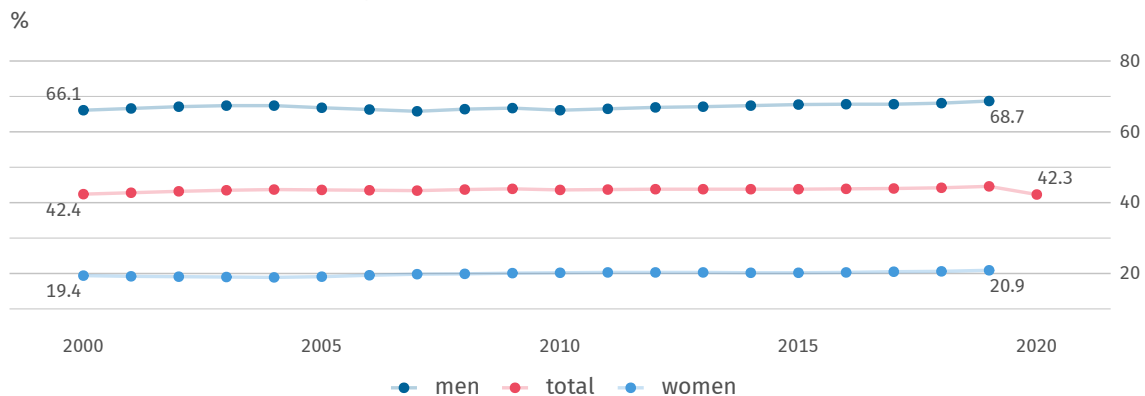

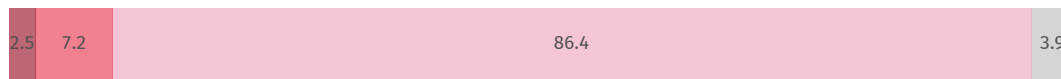
Employment and gross value added by sector 2020

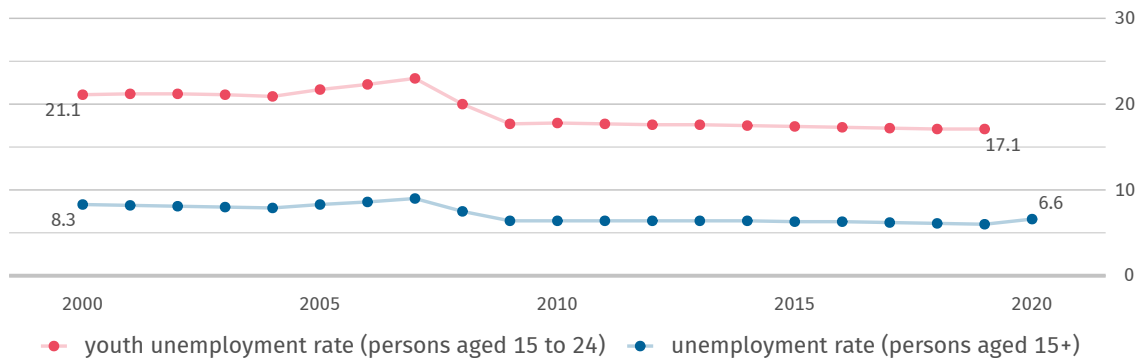

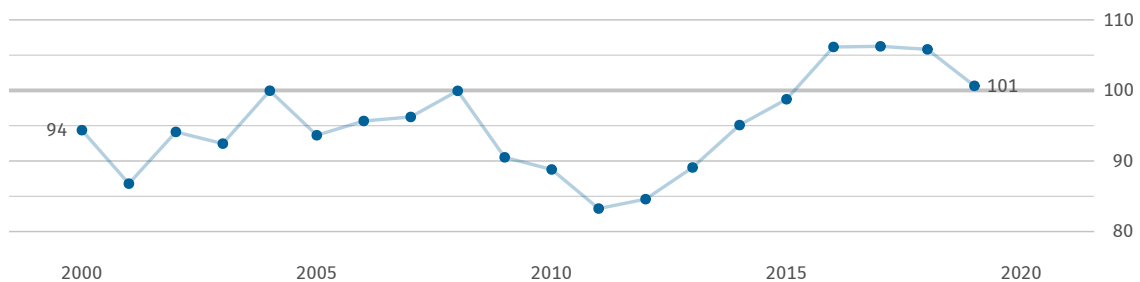

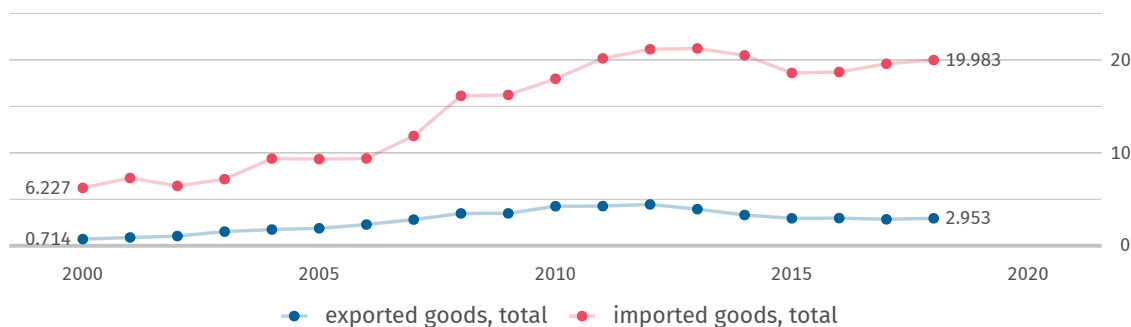

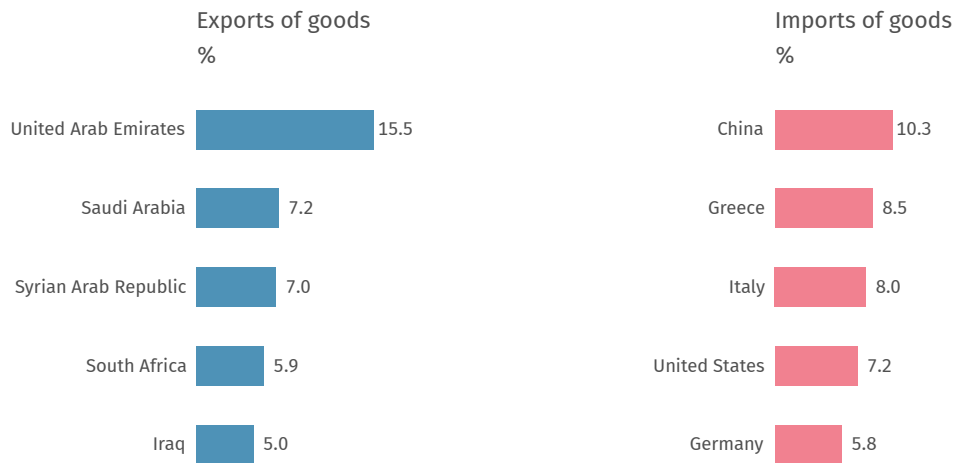

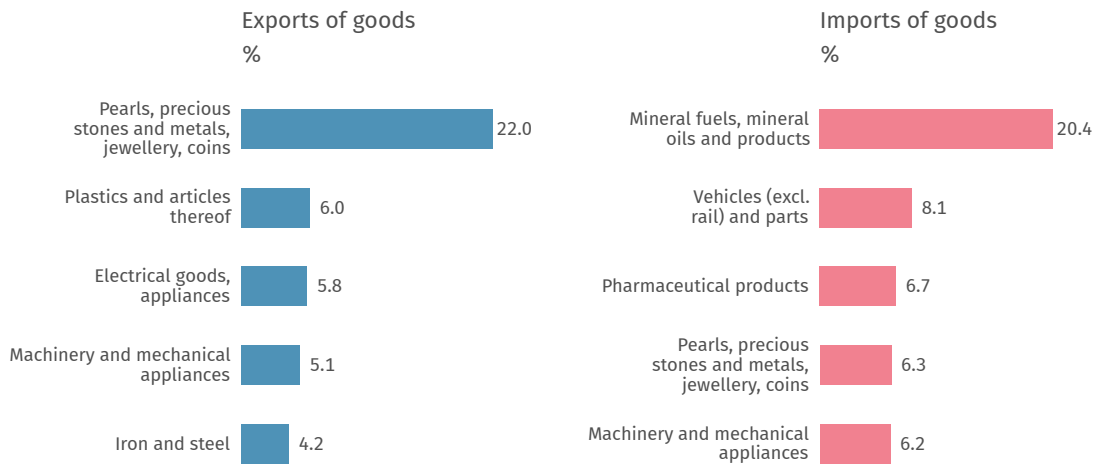

Main commodities traded 2018



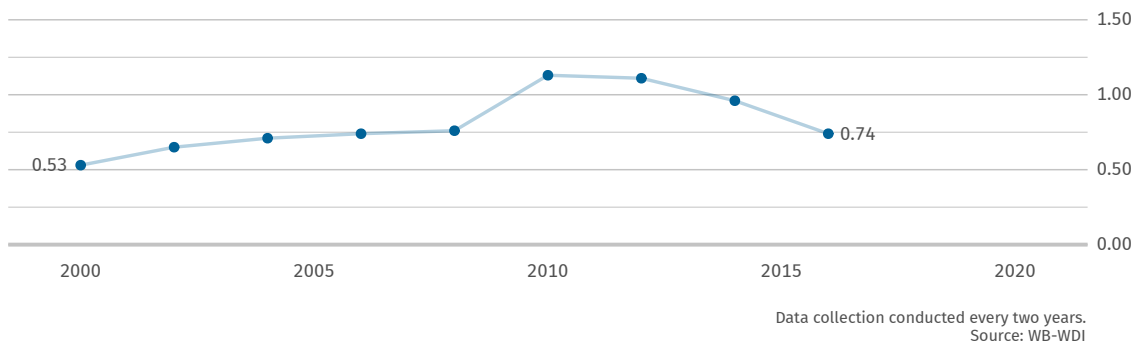

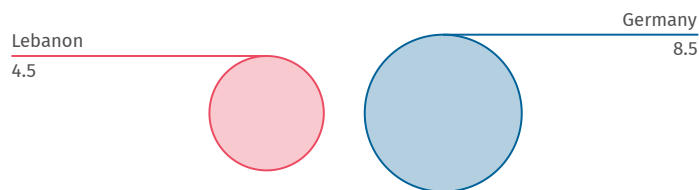
Gasoline price at the pump US\$ per litre

Carbon dioxide emissions in relation to Germany 2019 tonnes per capita



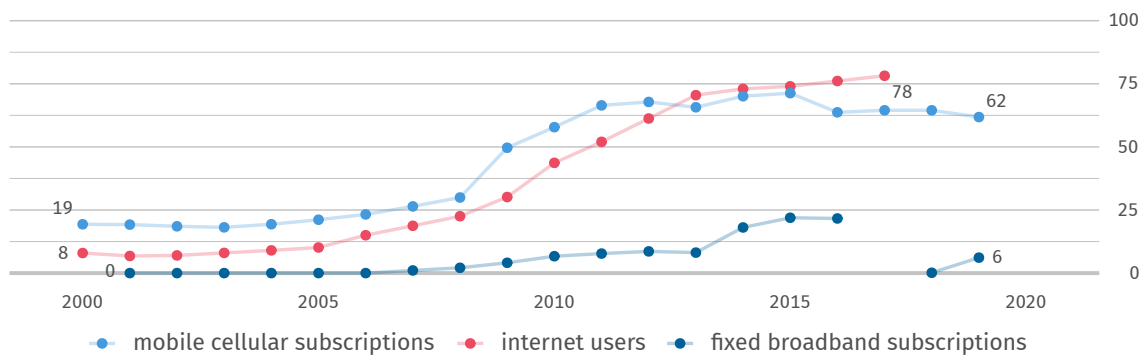
