مقدمة






Graph C.1: Hospitals contracting with MOPH by Mohafaza and type, 2013




Graph C.2 : MOPH subsidized admissions by type of hospital and location, 2013




Graph C.3: MOPH subsidized in-patients by Qada of origin and type of hospital, 2013

Graph C.6: MOPH subsidized admissions by category of diagnosis and gender, 2013 (N=276,773)






Graph D.1: Trend in MOPH Subsidized Hospitalized Cases of Neoplasms by Age Group, 2007-2013




Graph D.2: The trend in MOPH subsidized hospitalized Male cases of neoplasms by age group, 2007-2013

Graph D.5: MOPH subsidized hospitalized cardiovascular cases* by gender and Qada, 2013



■ OPV3 ■ (DPT-Hib-HepB)3 ■ MCV1








Graph H.1: Cumulative number of beneficiaries of the MOPH chronic drugs program* by age and gender, 2013




Graph H.2: Cases of chronic conditions receiving treatment through the MOPH chronic drugs program*, 2009-2013




Graph H.3: Distribution of chronic conditions among users of chronic drugs *, 2013
