مقدمة

يهدف أي نظام صحي في العالم إلى ضمان صحة الفرد وتوفير سبل الوقاية والعلاج بأقل كلفة ممكنة وضمان مستوى عال من الجودة لتحقيق التنمية الاجتماعية والاقتصادية المستدامة. إلا أن أي بلد من بلدان العالم لا يستطيع أن يقدر مدى تقدم أو تراجع حالة صحية ما من دون إحصاءات ومؤشرات. تتيح الإحصاءات الصحية فرصة مقارنة البلد بنفسه في فترات زمنية متعددة أو مقارنة عدة مناطق مع بعضها البعض، أو مقارنته مع باقي بلدان العالم.

تصدر النشرة الإحصائية عن وزارة الصحة العامة كتقرير سنوي جامع للإحصاءات المتوفرة في الوزارة، وتعزيزاً منها للشفافية في القطاع الصحي، إذ تحرص وزارة الصحة العامة على بناء السياسات الصحية المرتكزة إلى الأدلة العلمية وترشيد القرارات المتعلقة بتقديم وتوزيع الخدمات على المستفيدين وفقاً لآخر المعطيات الإحصائية والوبائية المتوفرة. بناء عليه، تندرج هذه النشرة ضمن الجهود التي تبذلها الوزارة لتحقيق أعلى مستوى صحي للفرد في لبنان عبر جمع الإحصاءات الحيوية والمعلومات عن التقديمات الصحية وكيفية توزيع الخدمات على الأراضي اللبنانية كافة بغية إشراك المواطن بالقرار وتأمين حقه بالاطلاع على تطورات القطاع الصحي.

تطورت تقديمات وبرامج وزارة الصحة مؤخراً بشكل مطرد وأصبح من الصعب مواكبة التطورات بدون نظام معلومات صحية يستطيع استخراج المؤشرات الدقيقة. معلومات هذه النشرة مستخرجة بمعظمها من قواعد بيانات الوزارة التي يتطور مستواها التقني يوماً بعد يوم نظراً للأهمية القصوى للمعلومات الصحية كواحدة من ركائز النظام الصحي الناجح.

إلى جانب ذلك، يجب التنويه بدور الأكاديميين والباحثين الصحيين كشركاء أساسيين في القطاع الصحي، والذين تدرج أولى اهتماماتهم بالبيانات الإحصائية حتى يصوبوا توجهاتهم في أبحاثهم ويساهموا مع صانعي القرار في بناء وتطوير القطاع الصحي.

إننا ننوه بالجهود المستمرة لرئيسة دائرة الإحصاءات الأنسة هيلدا حرب منذ بداية إصدار أعداد هذه النشرة والموظفين الذين عملوا على توفير المعلومات، ونخص بالشكر أيضاً منظمة الصحة العالمية على الدعم التقني لإمكانية جعل هذه النشرة بين أيديكم.

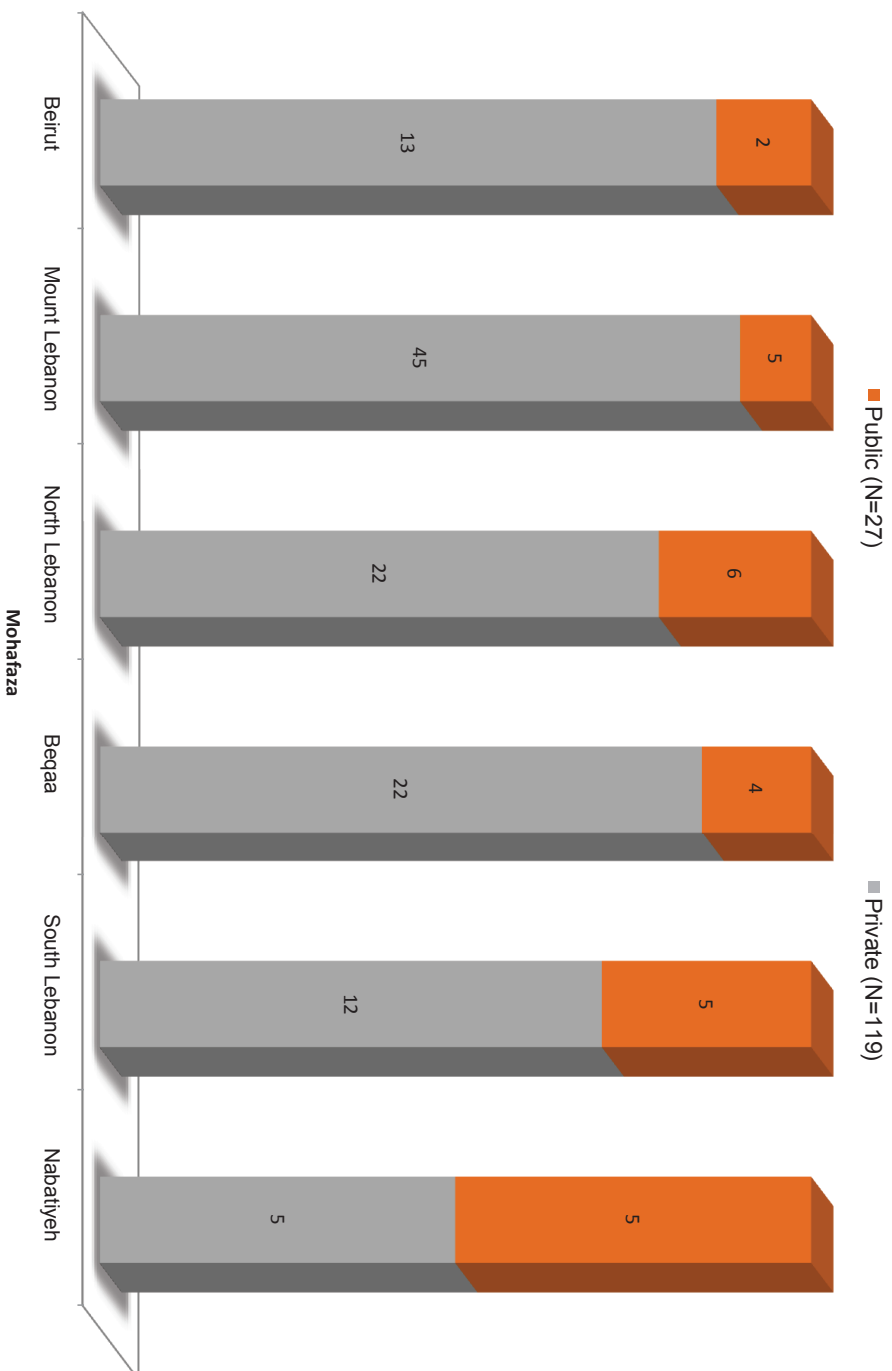

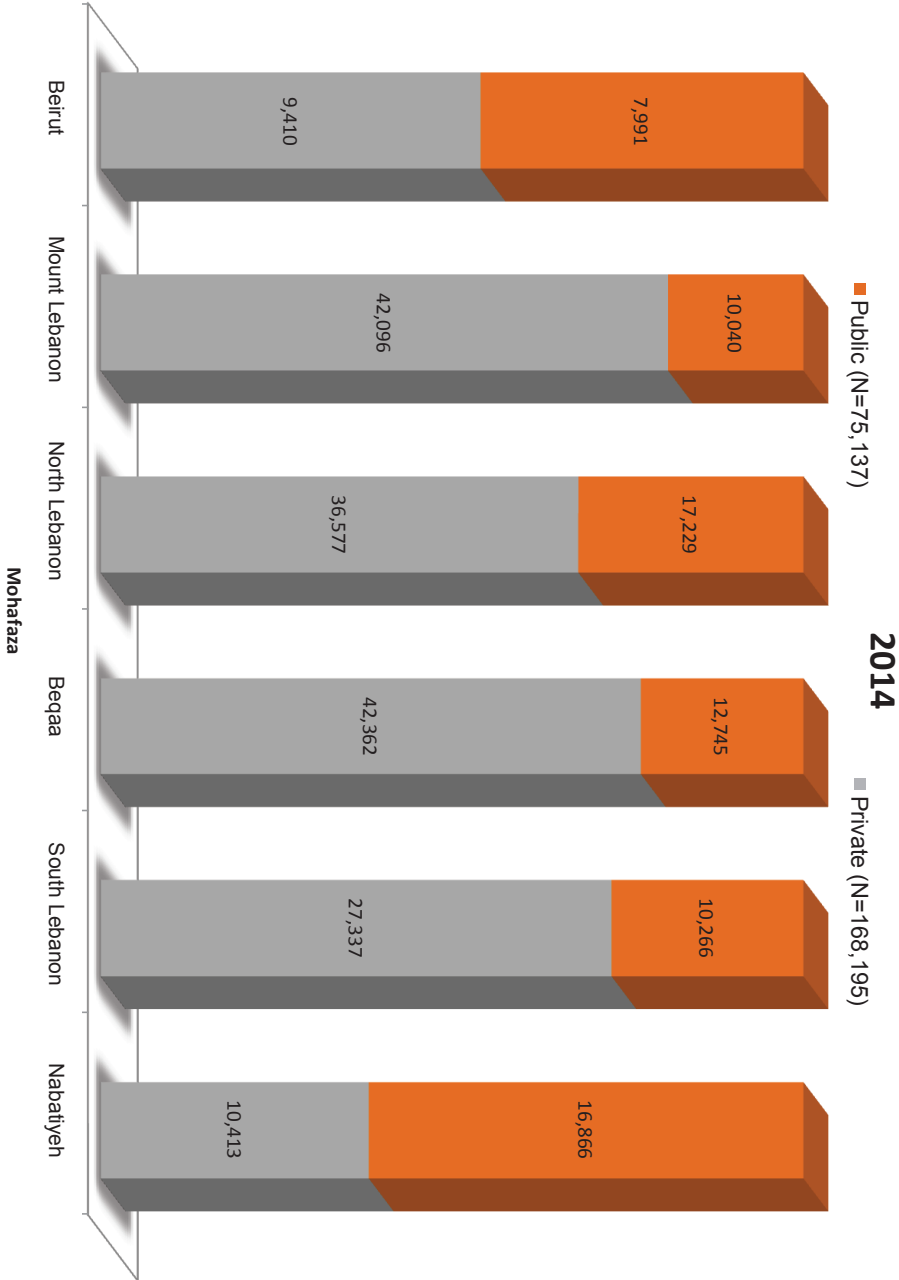

Graph C.1: Hospitals contracting with MOPH by Mohafaza and type, 2014

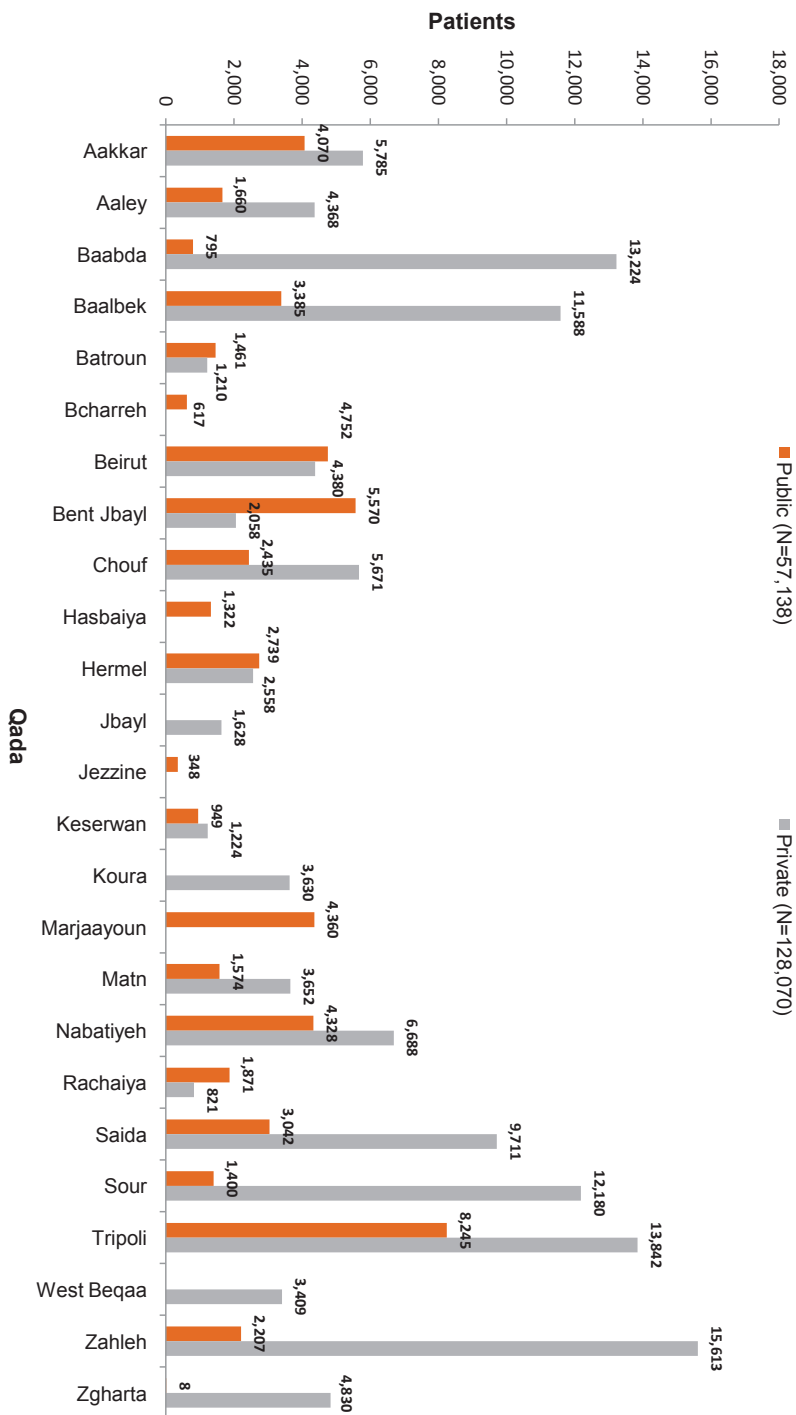


Graph C.2 : MOPH subsidized admissions by Mohafaza and type of hospital,



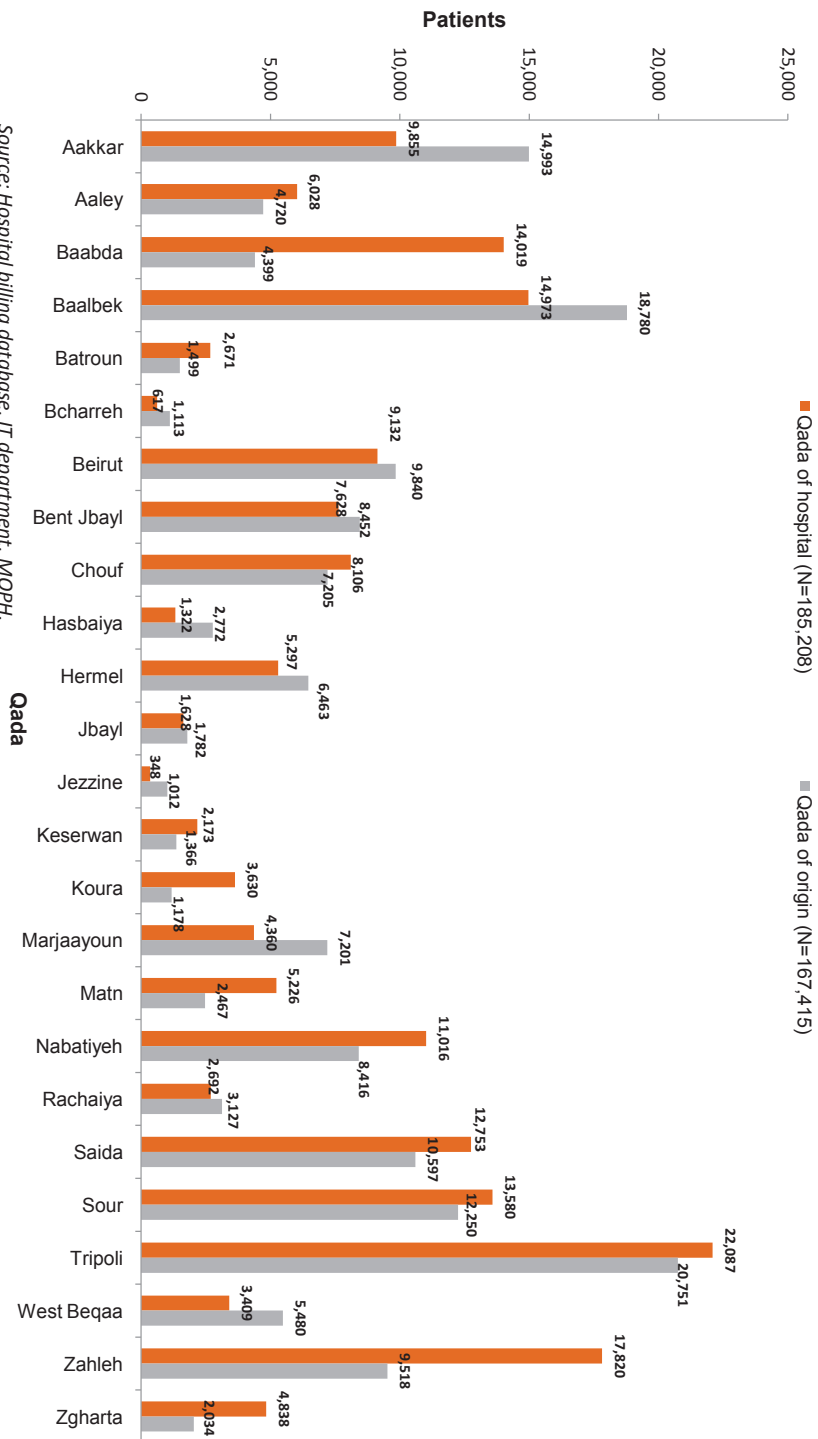

Graph C.3: MOPH subsidized in-patients by Qada and type of hospital, 2014



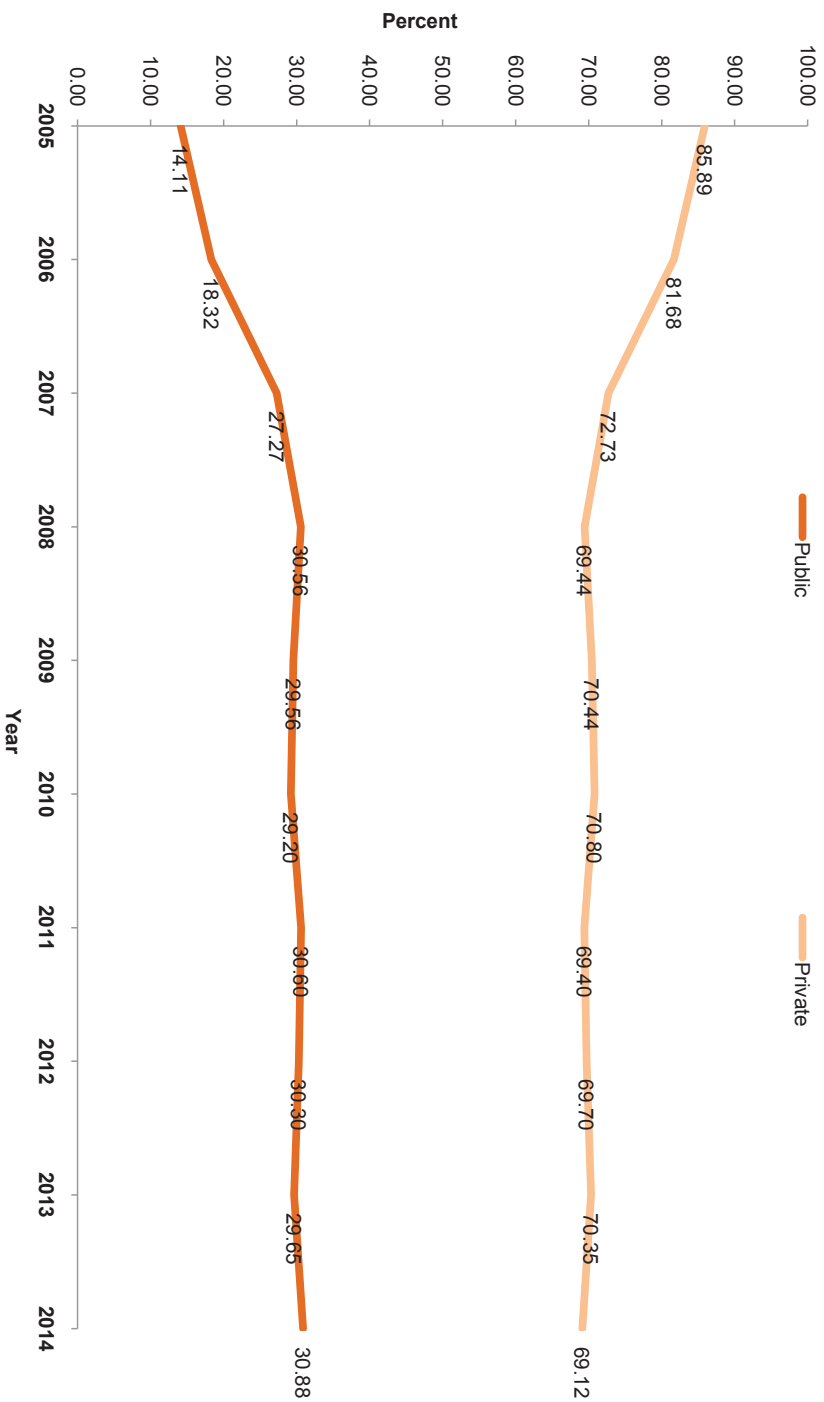

Graph C.4: MOPH subsidized in-patients by Qada of hospital and Qada of origin, 2014



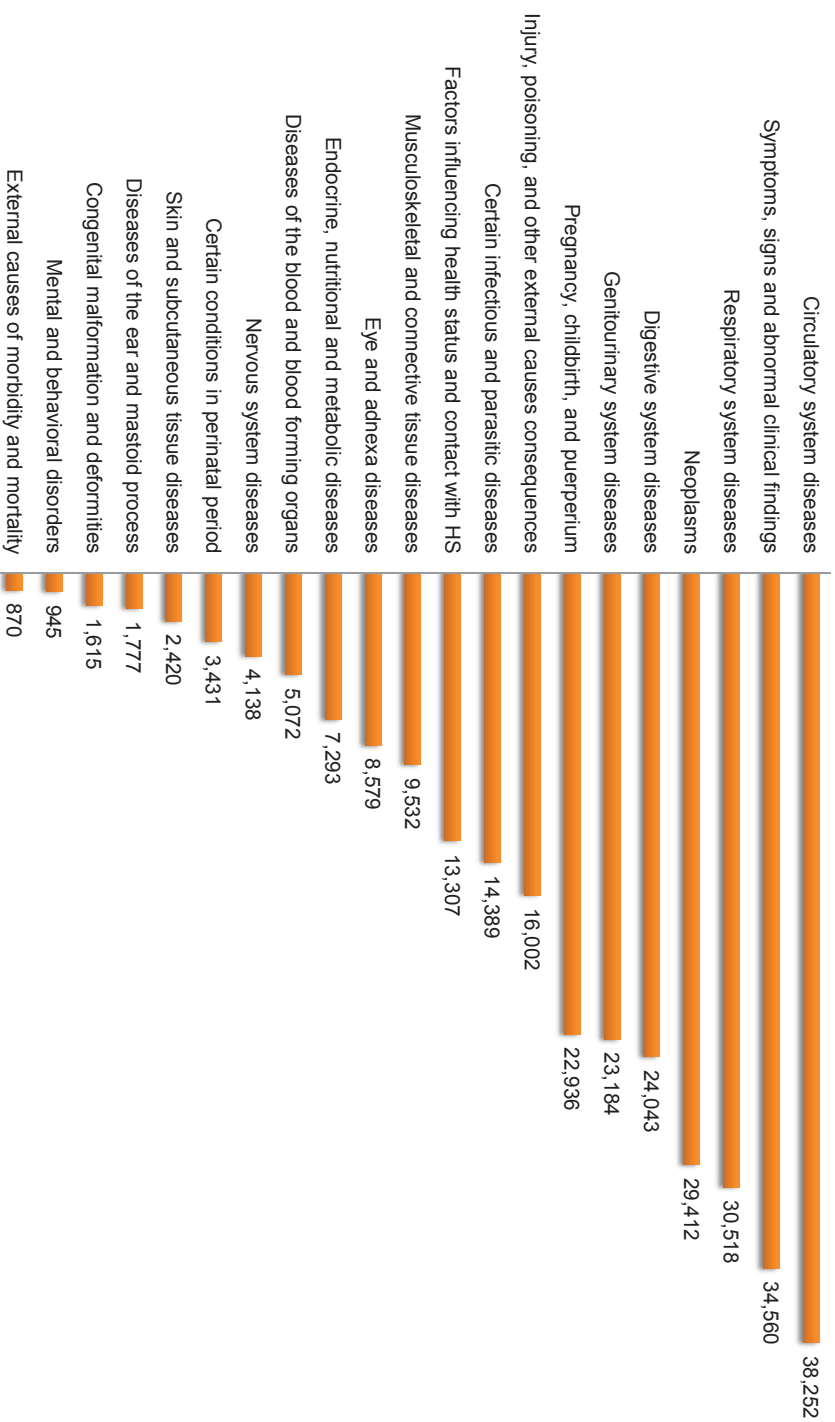

Graph C.5: The evolution of MOPH subsidized admissions in public and private hospitals between 2005 and 2014



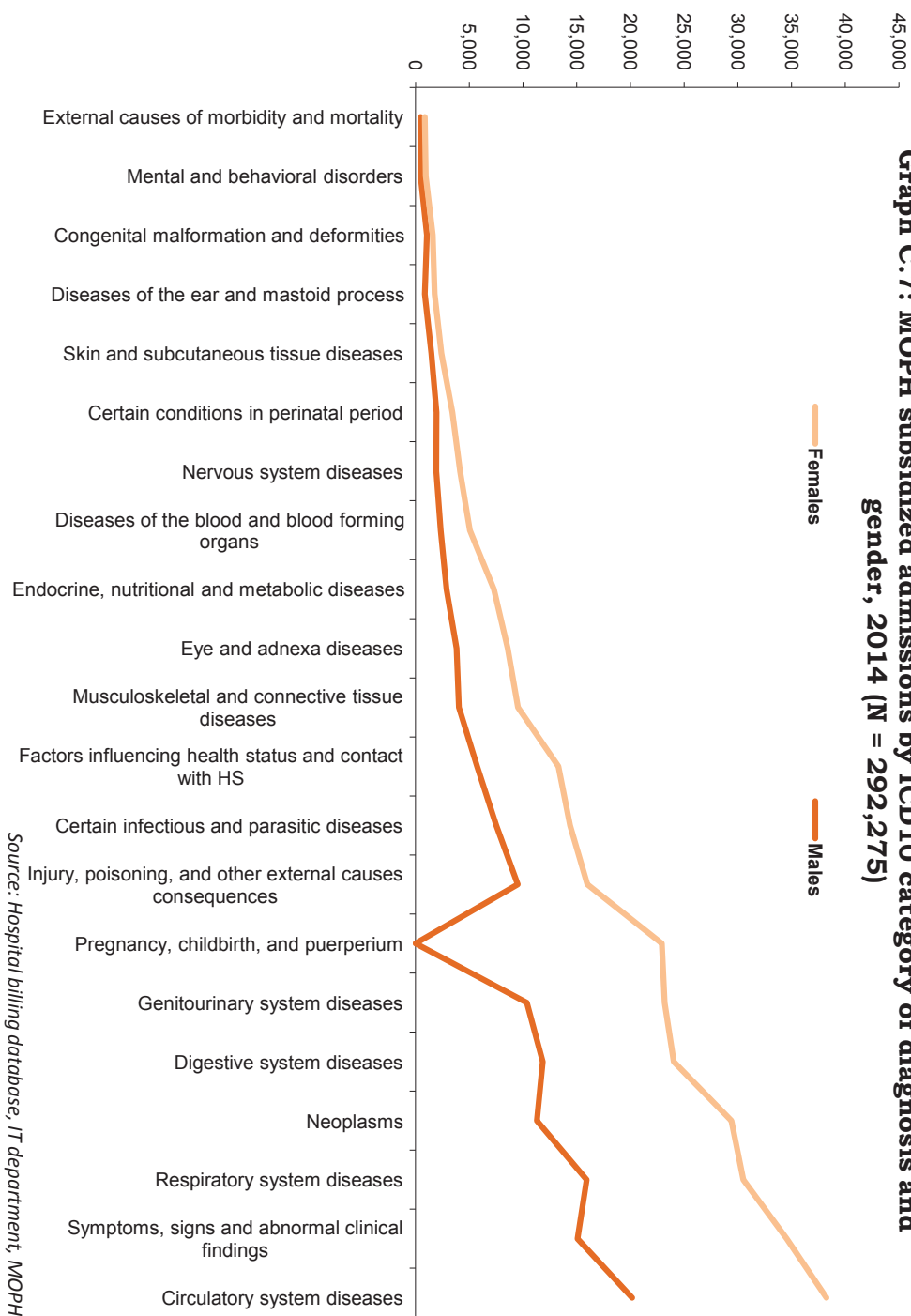

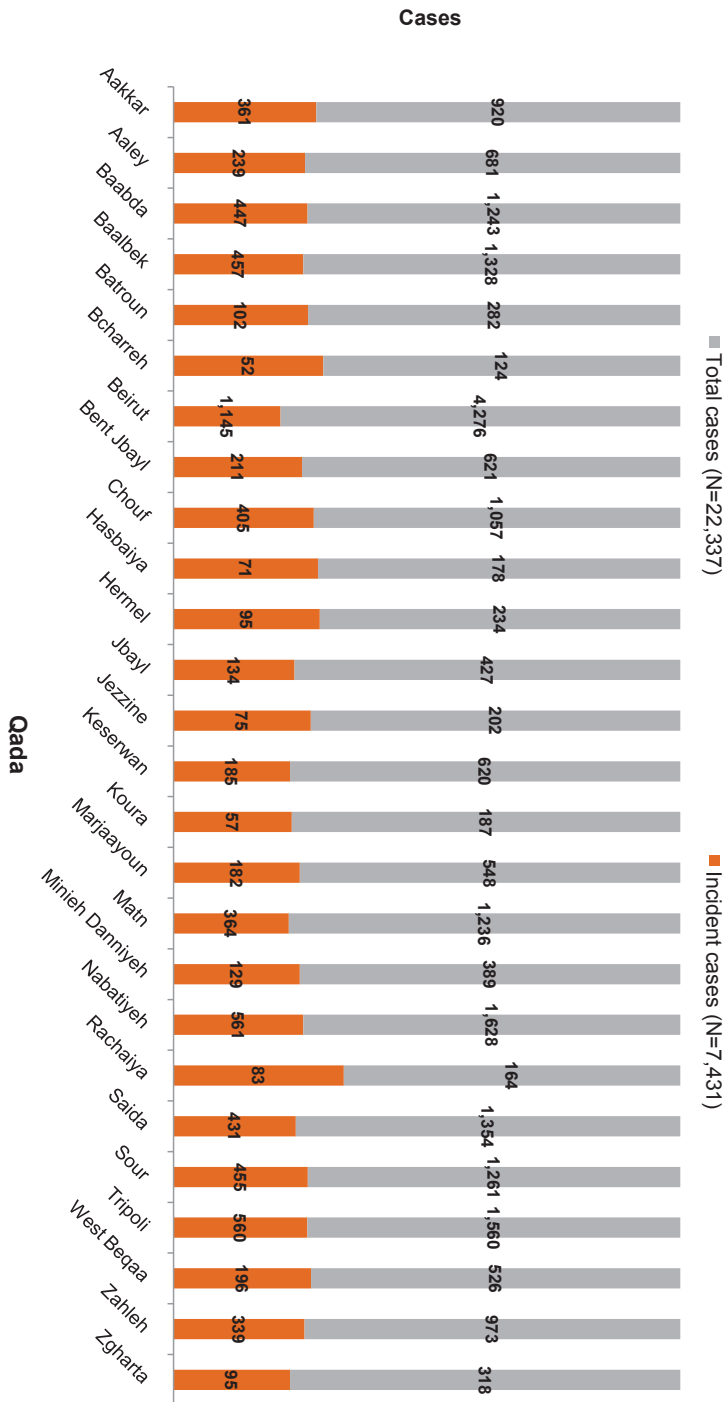

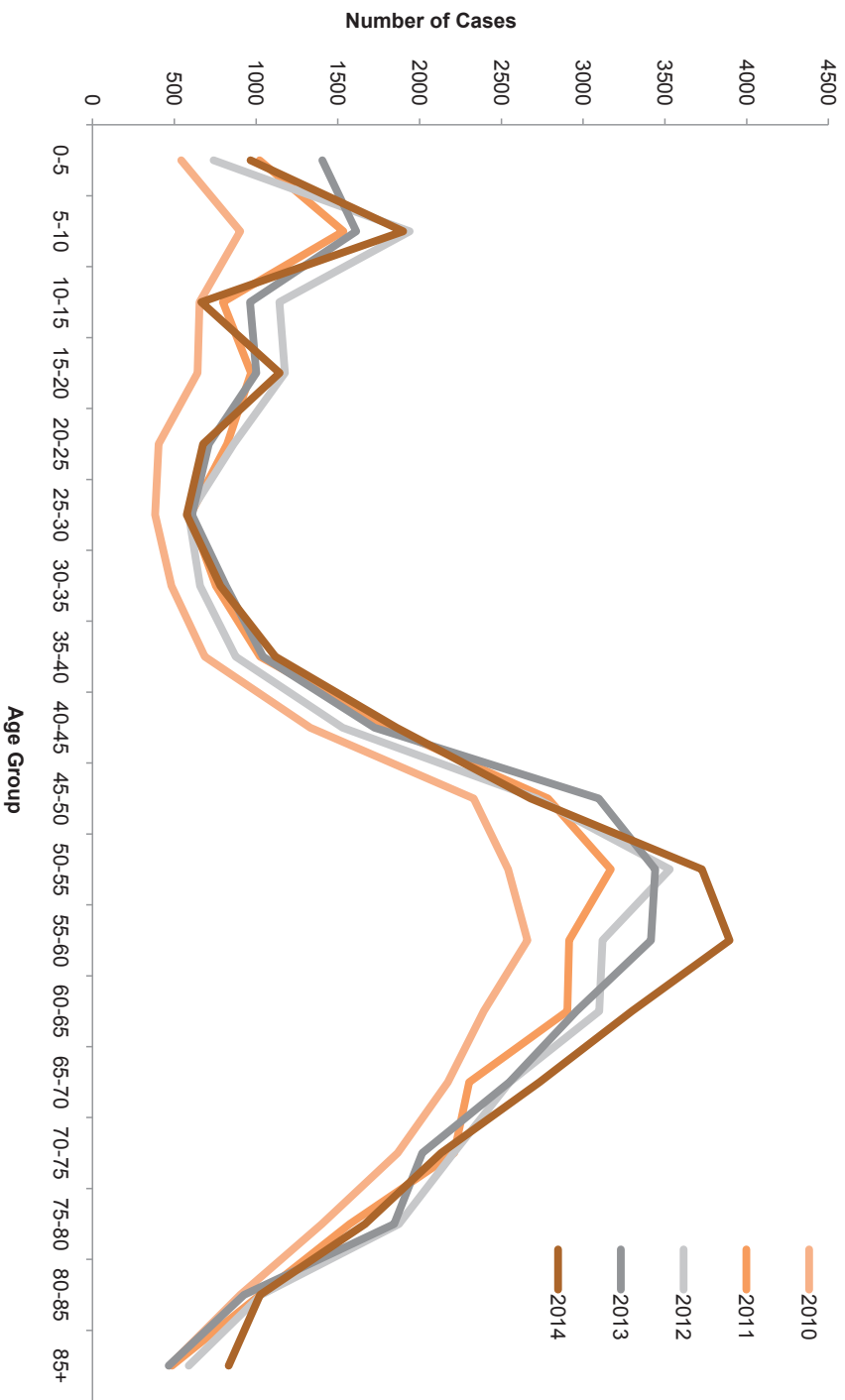
Graph C.8: Total and incident cases benefiting from the DDC* by Qada, 2014

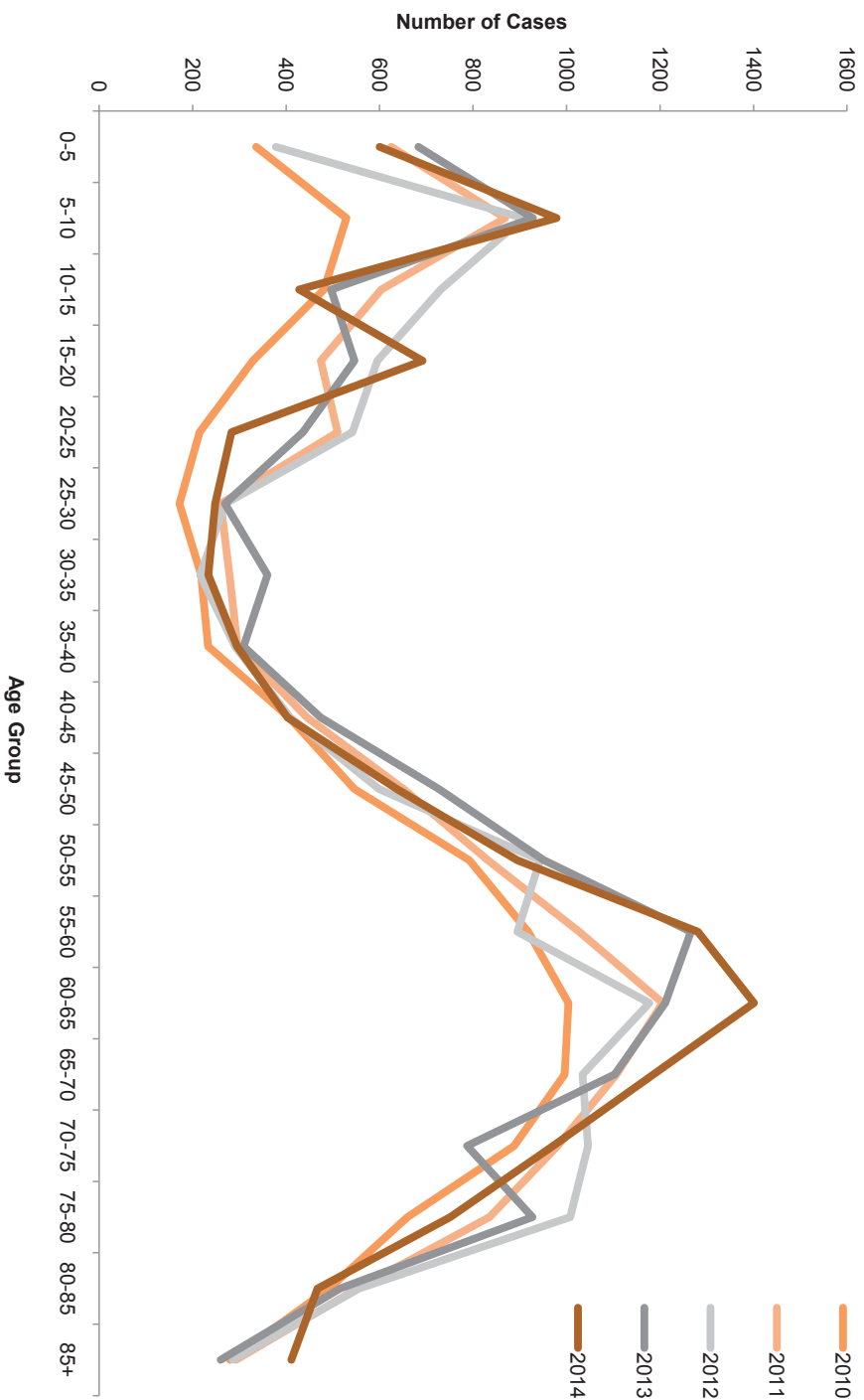

Graph D.1: The trend in MOPH subsidized hospitalized cases of neoplasms by age group, 2010-2014



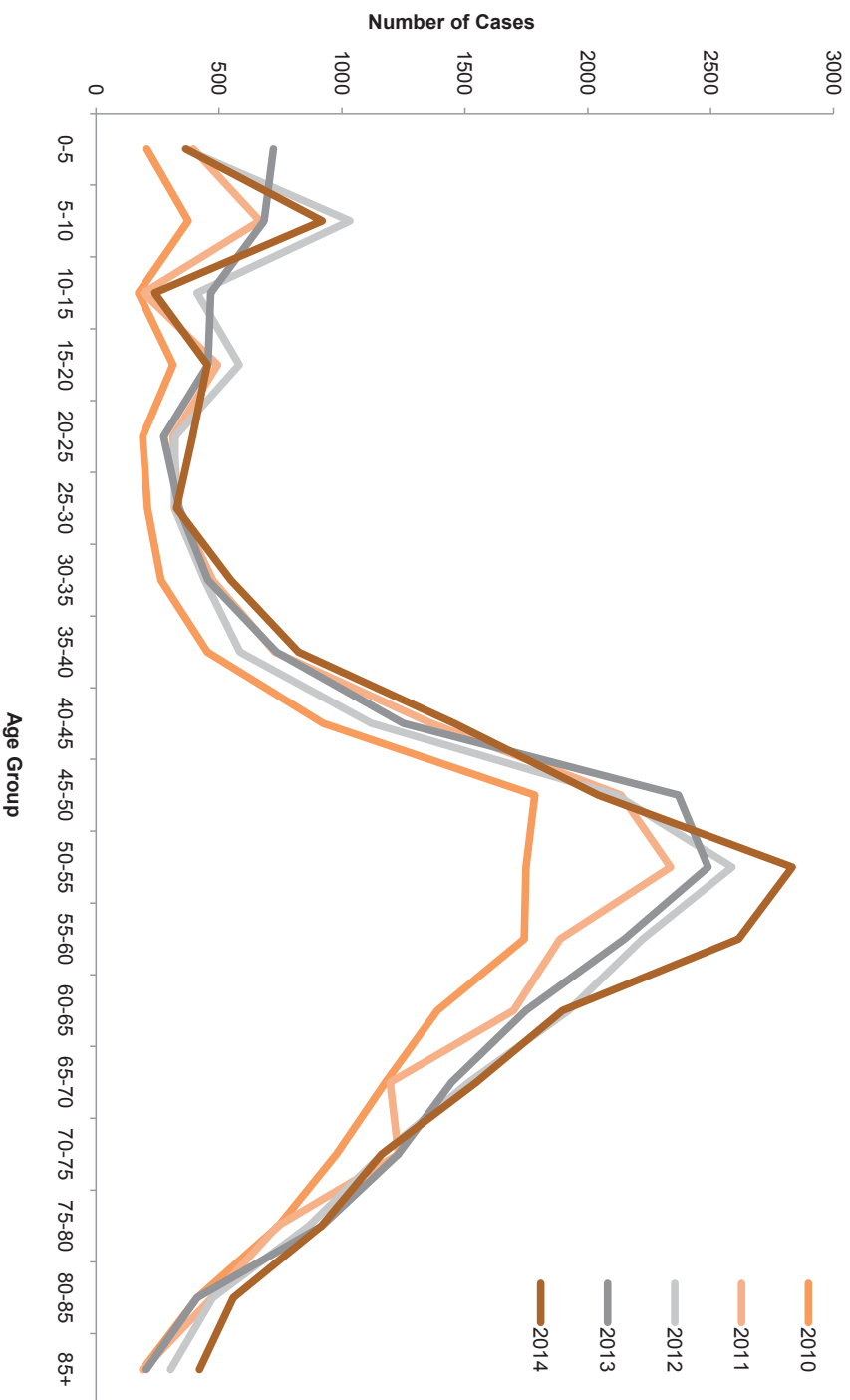

Graph D.2: The trend in MOPH subsidized hospitalized male cases of neoplasms by age group, 2010-2014



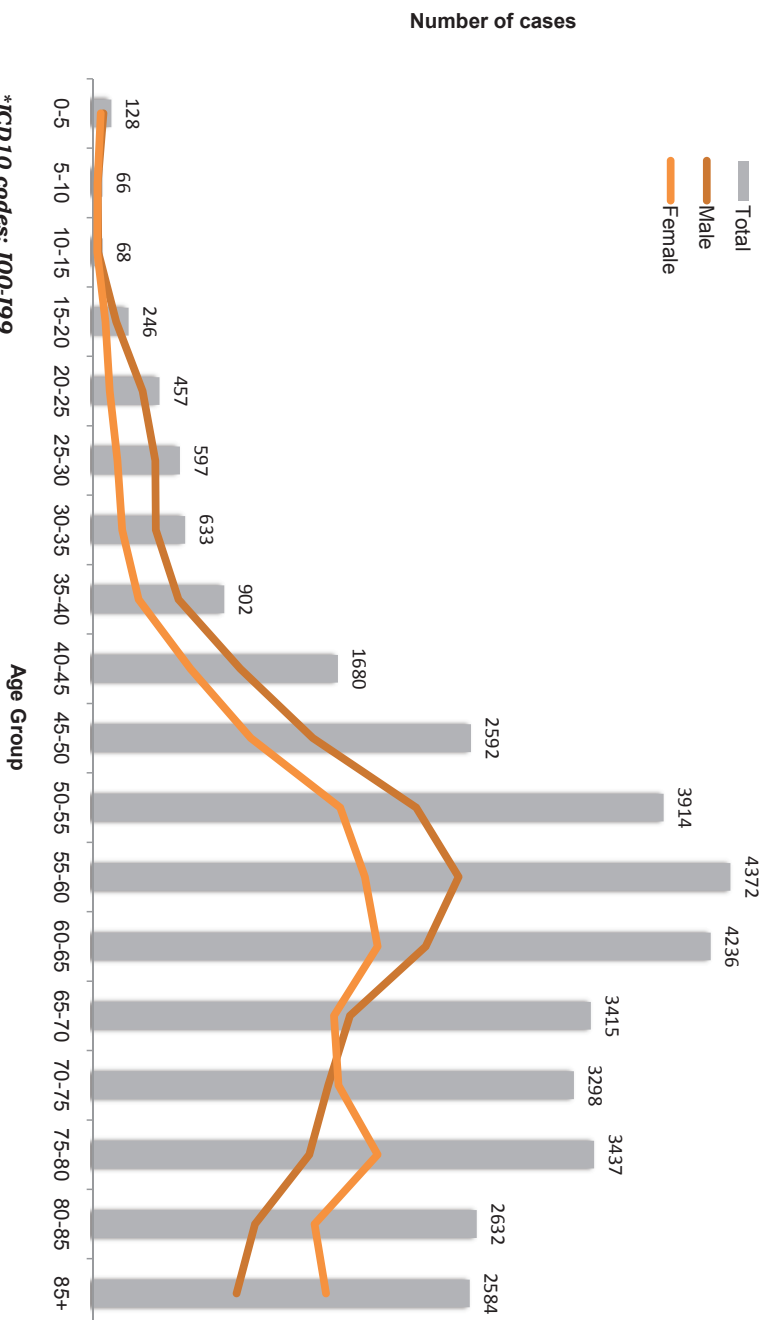

Graph D.3: The trend in MOPH subsidized hospitalized female cases of neoplasms by age group, 2010-2014

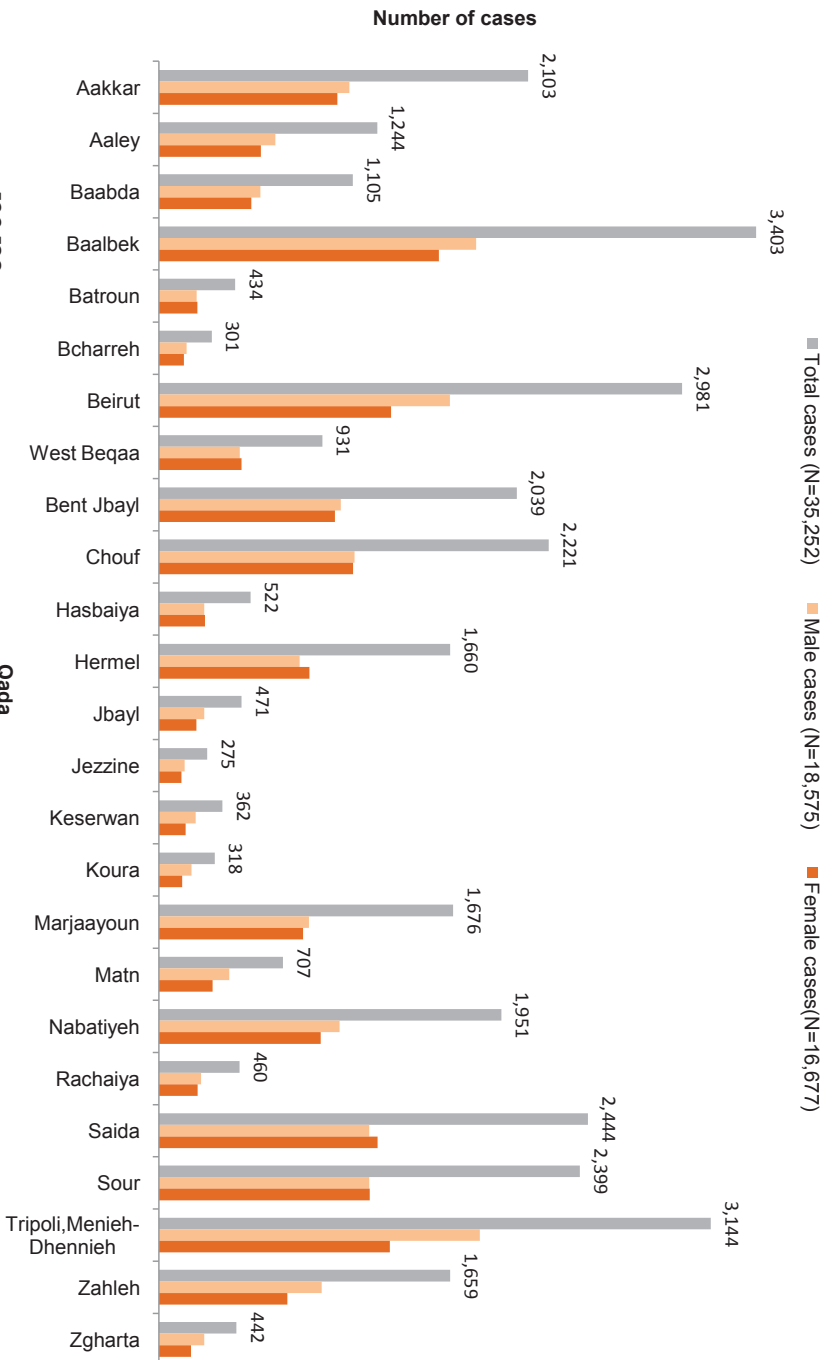

Graph D.4: MOPH subsidized hospitalized cardiovascular cases* by gender and age group, 2014



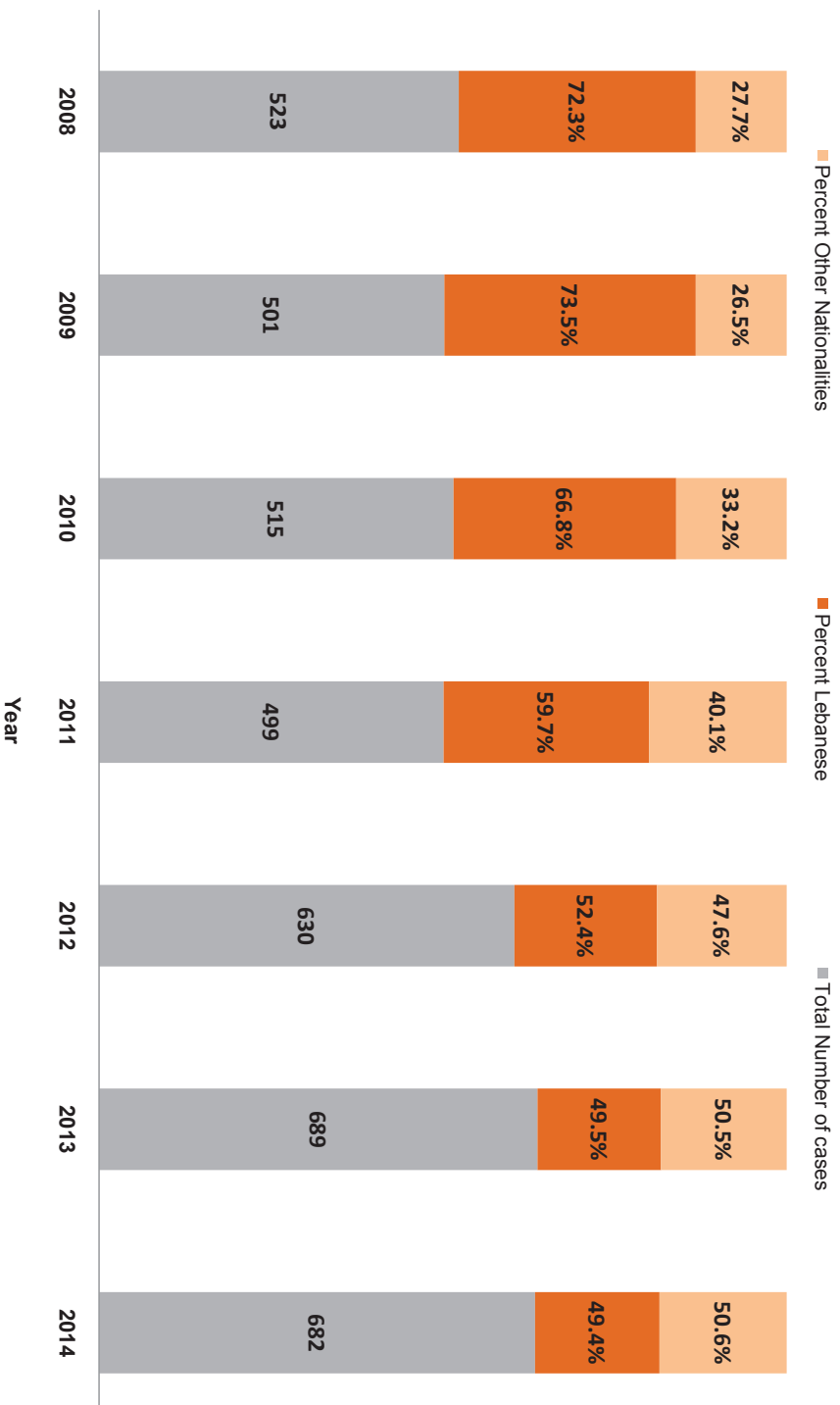
Graph D.5: MOPH subsidized hospitalized cardiovascular cases* by gender and Qada, 2014

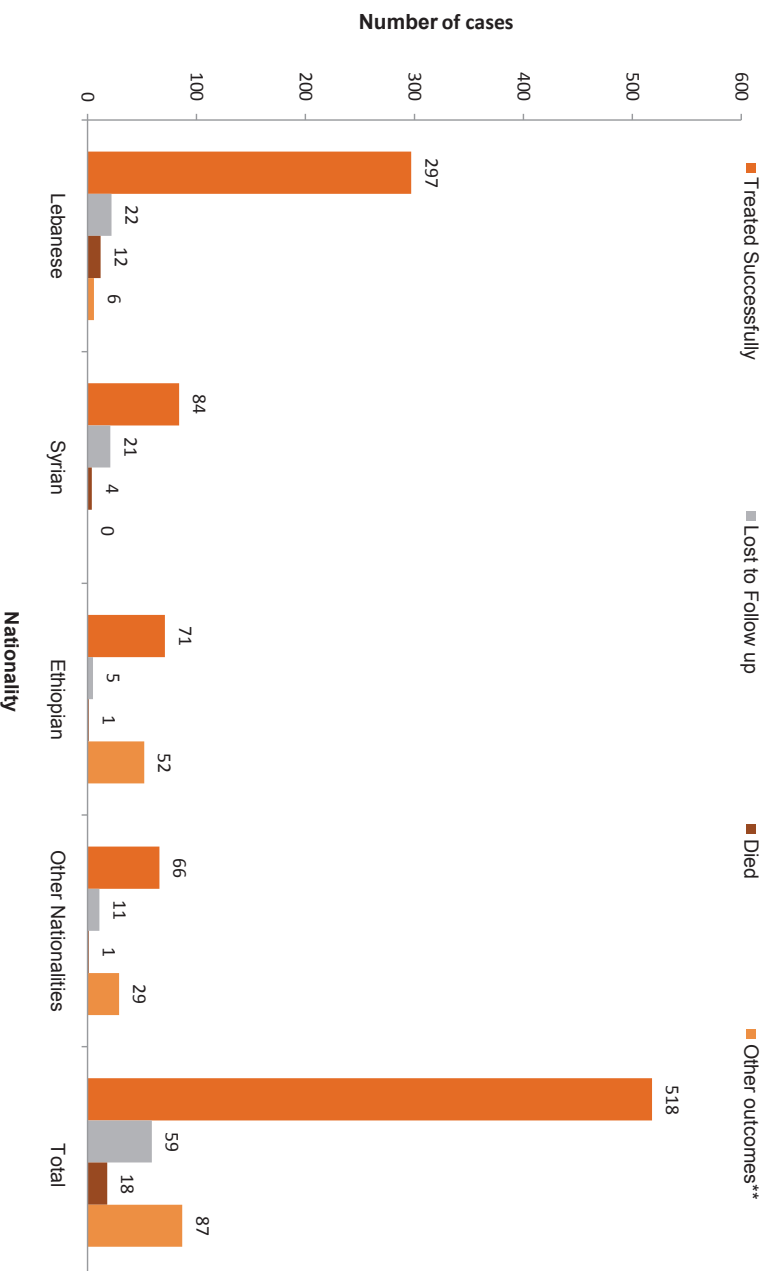

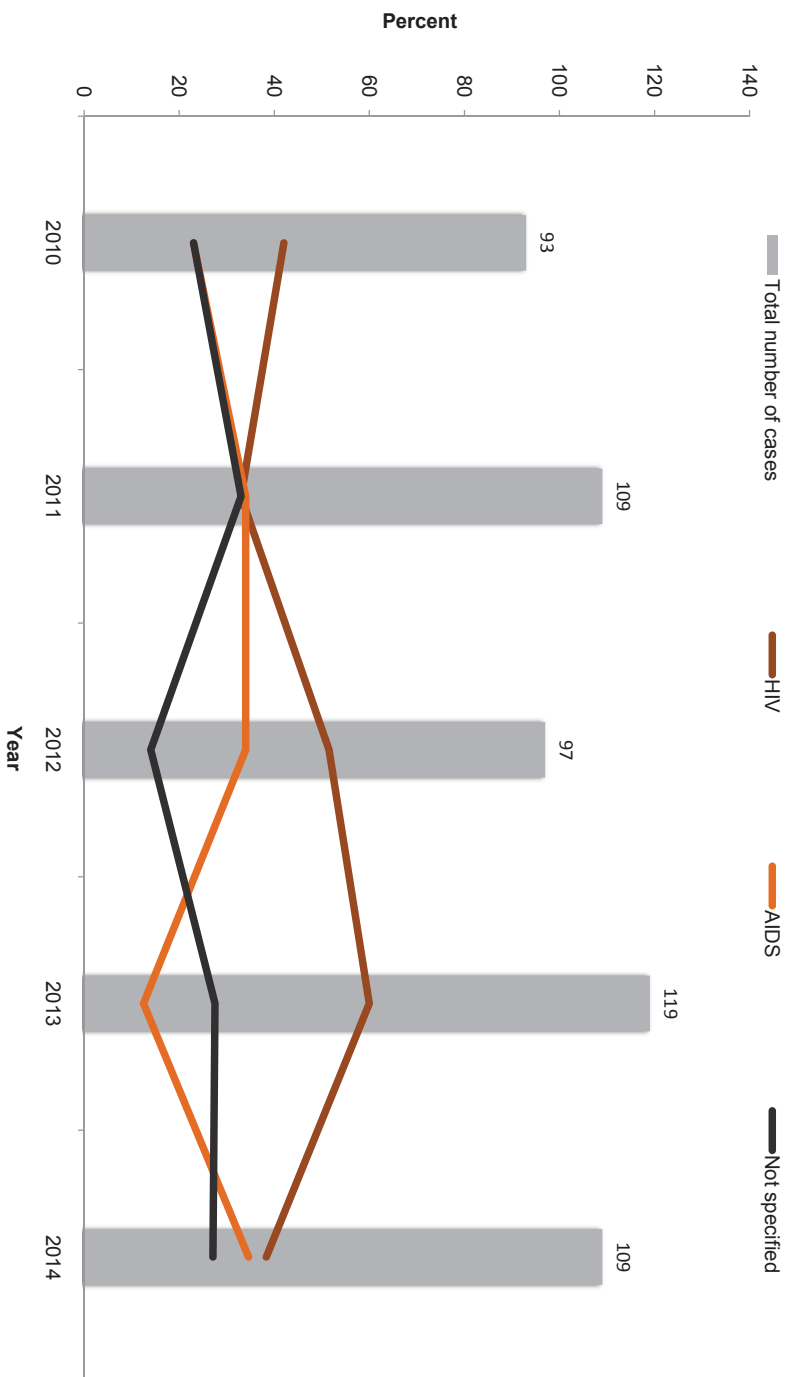

Graph D.8: The evolution of newly reported cases of HIV/AIDS between 2010 and 2014



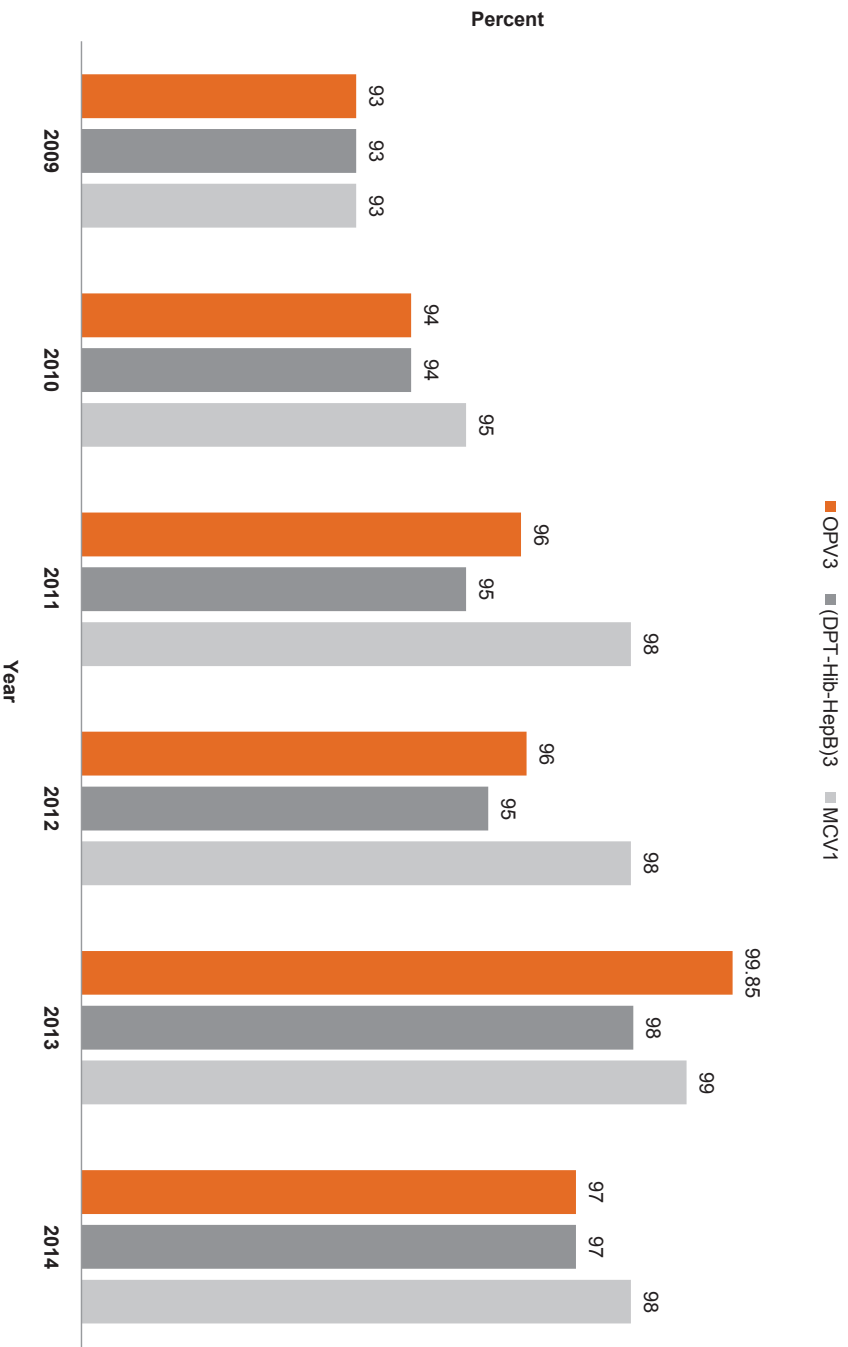

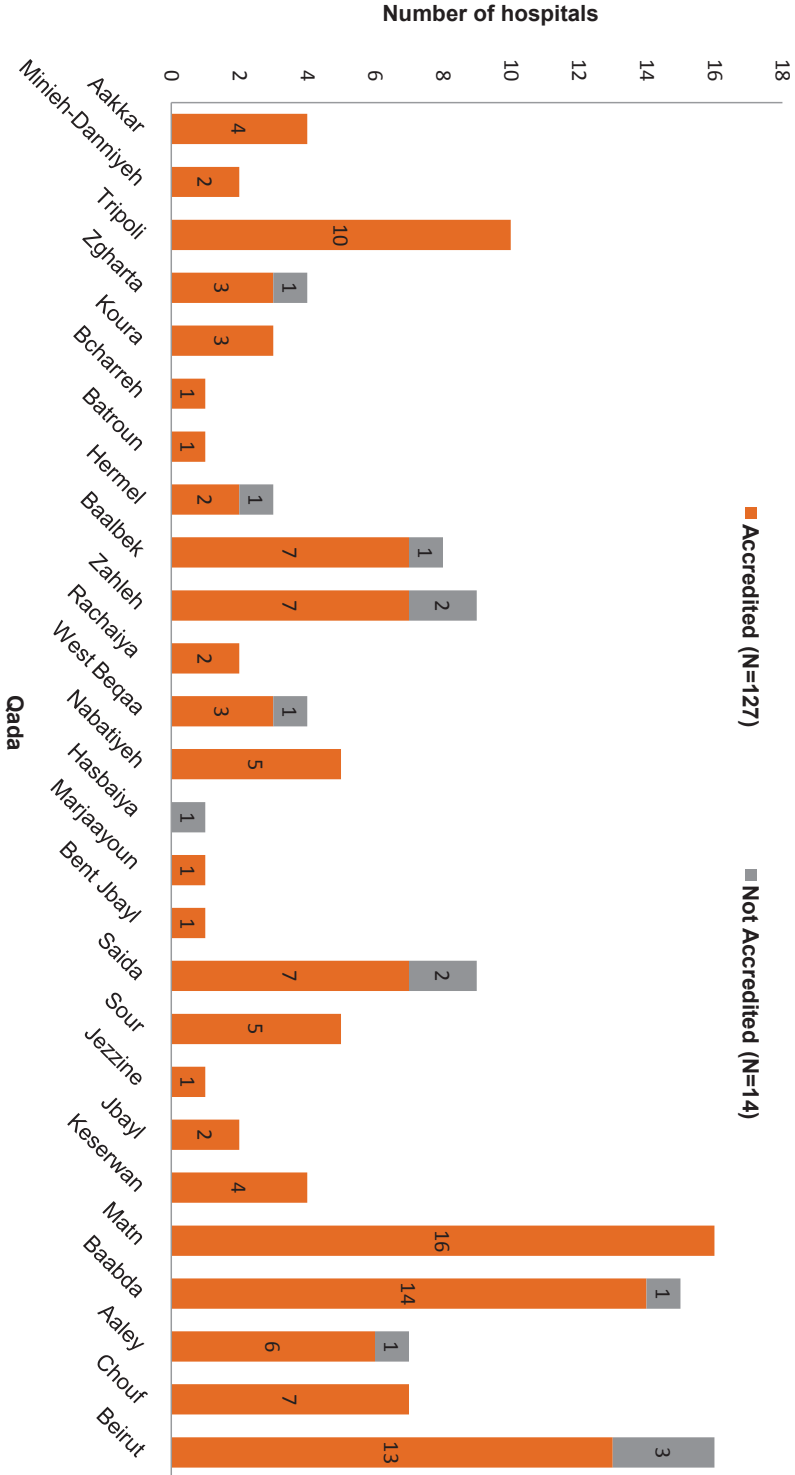

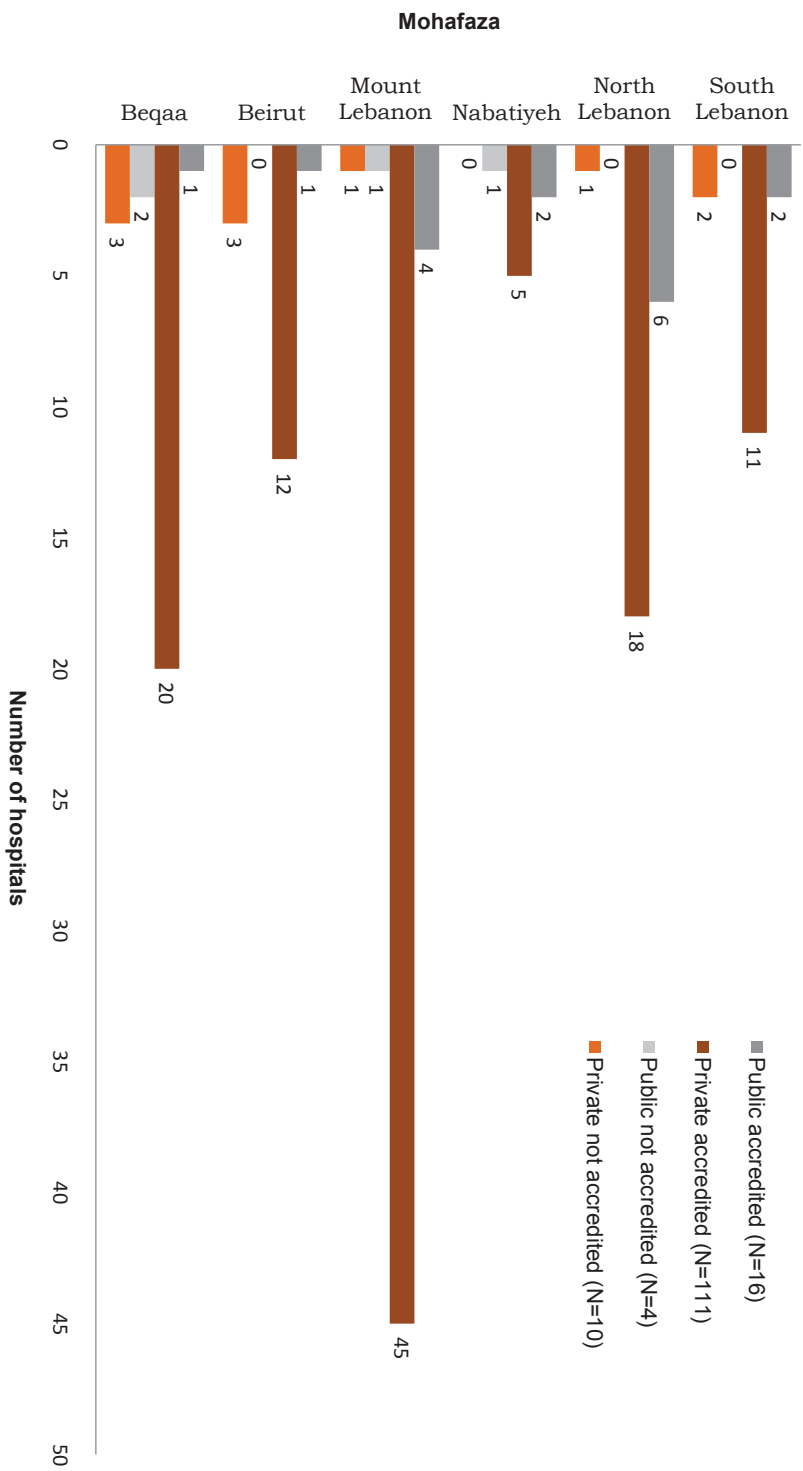
